Topic Original Report

MO: By pointing handgun at victim removing wallet from his pocket, taking cash from same and threatening to shoot victim

On 5-13-08 at 1808Hrs. I was detailed to 2073 Lark #3 on the report of a male who had been robbed at gunpoint by two other males on the street, in front of 11906 Madison, around 1600Hrs., two hours ago.

On arrival I spoke with VIC/WILLIAM COBB who was calm and explained the following. He was walking to the RTA rapid station on W.117th St. between 1600 and 1615Hrs. today. He walked to Madison from his street and crossed over to the north side, due to some large dogs being walked by people on the south side walk. As he neared 11906 Madison, he was asked by some unknown males in the described vehicle if he had a light. The auto was just forward of the sidewalk, in the parking lot of 11906 Madison, Nationality Broadcasting, facing towards the street. COBB walked over to the passenger window. At that point, the described driver, exited quickly, walking around the front of the auto and up to COBB. As he approached COBB, he pulled a small caliber, black automatic from the front of his waistband. COBB was next to the passenger door at that time. The described passenger male, leaned out the window, and began going through COBB's pants pockets. The passenger then removed COBB's wallet from his right, rear pocket, and went through it, removing a fifty and a one dollar bill. The passenger then dropped the wallet on the ground. The driver held the gun out, aimed at COBB during this. He then walked back to the drivers side and stated to COBB "You better run or I'll pop a cap in your ass!" COBB then jogged east bound on Madison. He looked back to see the auto pull out of the lot, turn west onto Madison and then north onto Hopkins. COBB then returned to the lot and collected his wallet and misc. papers from the ground.

COBB stated that he has never seen the auto or the two suspects before.

I asked COBB why he waited two hours to contact our department. He stated that he did not have his phone with him. I asked why he just didn't stop at one of the many businesses and have someone call us. COBB only stated that he was late meeting his fiance and figured that he had just better return home, not knowing what to do.

I explained to COBB how unusual it was for someone robbed at gunpoint to wait two hours to call the police. I also asked him if he was making a false report to cover the fact that he lost/spent money so as not to upset his fiance. COBB was very polite and calm and insisted that his story was true.

COBB further stated that he believes the auto to be a Honda, possibly an accord, maybe an older boxy model and that it had a spoiler on the back. When I questioned him on the plate, he stated that there was no plate on the rear. He thinks it may have had a temp tag displayed in the rear window.

COBB stated that he would recognize the two suspects if he saw them again. He stated that he desired prosecution if they are found.

I responded to the scene and spoke with the operations manager of Nationality Broadcasting, OIV/JAMES GEORGIADES. He stated that he did observe a small black Honda, possibly a four door with two males inside, parked in the entrance way, just forward of the sidewalk around 1600Hrs. He could not recall the victim's clothing, but stated that a black male matching the victim's physical was

outside of the car, talking to them. GEORGIADES stated that the male outside of the car (possibly COBB) had a large white, plastic shopping bag with him. GEORGIADES kept walking in and out of the lobby and saw the vehicle and male talking to the occupants for about a five minute period. He did not see them continuously but never saw anyone exit the auto. He could not see who was inside and did not recognize the auto.

GEORGIADES stated that his business has a lobby camera but that it is angled, only seeing a short distance outside of the front door. The camera does not record.

I later did a CCH on COBB. It shows many arrests for trafficking and other drug related offenses.
