Topic Original Report

MO: By forcing front door of apartment, gaining entry and taking coins, currency and jewelry without owners permission.

On 1-31-08, at 1607Hrs., I was detailed to 1116 Cook Ave. #31 to take a burglary report.

On arrival I met with VIC/ROBERT MCCARTHY who relayed the following - He received a call just after 1530Hrs. from his [redacted], OIV/ [redacted], stating that the front door had been broken in. ROBERT hurried home to find the damage to the door. He then proceeded to the bedroom to find a locker type safe pryed open and a jewelry box open with several items thrown about the room.

ROBERT indicated that his [redacted] had some drawers opened in their bedroom but that nothing was missing.

Upon checking the apartment, I observed the front door frame severely damaged with wood fragments on the floor. The door appeared to have simply been forced open. No items in the living room appeared disturbed (DVDs, TV and components.) I then checked ROBERT's bedroom. There were several items, some jewelry, a jewelry box and paperwork thrown about the bed and floor. The locker safe was located in plain view, in the corner of the room. It had been pryed and forced open.

ROBERT indicated that the three long guns he owns were still in their cases inside the safe and were not disturbed. He advised that these are the only firearms in the home. He stated that the coins taken were located in the locker as well, along with the currency. The jewelry was taken from the wooden box that was located on the dresser.

ROBERT also stated that he kept a three gallon water jug next to his bed that was about half full of change. He found the jug, empty, on his living room couch.

ROBERT indicated that he was missing a pillow case from one of his pillows from his bed.

ROBERT was not certain of the values of his collectible coins or jewelry and gave estimations. He was not sure what his renters insurance would cover.

The back door to the apartment was still locked. The lobby door appeared to be secure and I had to be buzzed in by ROBERT on my arrival.

I spoke with ROBERT's [redacted] and OIV/ [redacted] advised that [redacted] was the last one to leave the home [redacted], around [redacted] Hrs. I asked both of them if they had any suspects in this matter. Both stated that they rarely have any friends over and had no suspects.

INV. MOHER responded on scene for ET work.

ROBERT advised that he heard from the landlord that his neighbor, one below and across the hallway in #28, had heard noise from his apartment around 1100Hrs. today. He apparently thought at the time that work was being done. He supposedly did not see anyone. ROBERT stated that he only knows the tenant there as Bret.

ROBERT's apartment is located at the top of the staircase. The apartment directly across from him and the apartment below him are empty. (There are two units on each floor in the building.)

The mail boxes in the lobby do not have names listed. I could not find any information for #28 in the computer. Nobody was home at the apartment at the time of report.

ROBERT stated that he has lived in the building for two years with his daughters. He had no suspects. He was advised of the low solvability factor of this report. ROBERT understood and stated that he desired prosecution if a suspect is developed.

I later stopped at Giant Eagle to inquire about anyone using their coin exchange machine. Employees at the service desk did not notice anyone that had used the machine between 1100 and 1530Hrs. They did print me the amount for transactions that took place. The two highest were for eighty-seven and sixty-two dollars, just prior to 1500Hrs. Managment was not available to review the surveillance cameras.
