Topic Original Report

M.O.: By violating a duty of care for her children ages 9 and 9 months, by being voluntarily intoxicated to the point of not being able to assure the safety of her children.

M.O.: By being voluntarily intoxicated, causing a risk of harm to herself and/or others.

On 2/21/08, at 1920 hrs, Officer Mullen and I responded to 15033 Hilliard regarding a female that lives on the second floor yelling at her kids for over an hour. When I arrived on scene, I could hear a female yelling. When Officer Mullen walked towards the side of the house, he was met by OIV/ROBERT ROBERT indicated he was glad we were here, and asked us to hurry upstairs to hear his mother, ARA/STACEY LETTERLY, screaming at his brother hysterically. ROBERT informed us of the following:

ROBERT indicated he had come over to LETTERLY's, to pick up his brother, OIV/ had called and stated his mother was drunk and she was screaming at him causing him to be scared. When ROBERT came to pick him up, LETTERLY refused to allow to go with ROBERT and kicked ROBERT out of the house. Before leaving, ROBERT told to just go into his room, lock his door, and go to sleep. ROBERT then told in the morning he could talk to the school counselor about the situation. While ROBERT was standing outside of the residence, he received another phone call from was upset, and told ROBERT that LETTERLY was still screaming at him, trying to kick open his bedroom door. It was at this time we arrived on scene. While on scene, called ROBERT again. ROBERT put him on speaker phone and told him the police were at the house. was crying and then hung up the phone. When ROBERT tried to call him back, there was no answer.

Officer Mullen and I knocked and announced our presence to LETTERLY. LETTERLY was moving around inside the apartment, but would not say a word. After knocking several times on the door, and repeatedly telling LETTERLY it was the police, we received no answer. ROBERT attempted to call her phone, which could be heard ringing inside, but received no answer. Dispatch attempted to contact her as well, with no success.

In speaking with ROBERT further, it was learned LETTERLY is an alcoholic, and has been drinking more and more lately. It was also learned ROBERT's 9 month old sister was also inside the apartment along with I contacted Sgt. Eschweiler regarding the matter. He indicated that if she was refusing to open the door, we would have to force entry to ensure the safety of the children.

We again attempted to make contact with LETTERLY, and informed her if she refused to answer, we would have to force entry. We again received no response. I kicked out a panel of the rear door, allowing us to unlock the lock to gain entry to the apartment. We found LETTERLY, and OIV/ , locked in the bathroom. I again told LETTERLY if she did not unlock the door, we would force entry. unlocked the door at this time.

Officer Mullen spoke with , while I spoke with LETTERLY. LETTERLY had a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage on her breath, had bloodshot and glassy eyes, was slightly unsteady on her feet, and staggered as she walked, causing a risk of harm to herself and others. LETTERLY indicated she became upset with because of his grades. While yelling at , she indicated she disciplined him by smacking him once.

indicated LETTERLY became upset over his bad grades in school, and began yelling at him. stated when LETTERLY drinks, she becomes angry and extremely loud. Over the last few months, LETTERLY's drinking has steadily increased. stated tonight, while arguing about the grades, his mother smacked the back of his head, which is uncharacteristic, and made him scared. This is why he said he locked himself in his room. There were no visible injuries to and there were no signs of physical abuse.

LETTERLY was placed under arrest for DCI and Child Endangering. LETTERLY agreed it would be okay for her children to stay with ROBERT. ROBERT was willing to take the children with him, and indicated he would take care of the door that was damaged. I transported LETTERLY to the station. While waiting in the stall, LETTERLY asked several times why she was being arrested, which was explained to her. When I told her she was arrested for being intoxicated, she stated "who cares I'm drunk". LETTERLY didn't seem to understand why she couldn't be drunk in her own home. LETTERLY was booked by C.O. Bunner, Disp. Sykora and myself.

While at the booking window, LETTERLY indicated she worked at a local restaurant and threatened to spit in Police Officer's food when they place an order. LETTERLY was issued citation [REDACTED] for Child Endangering, and [REDACTED] DCI.

I contacted 696-KIDS and spoke with Johnson. She was given the pertinent information, and she gave me ID#

Inv. Deucher took photos of the damage to the door.
