Topic Original Report

M.O.: By entering the restaurant, and attempting to take the tip jar off of the counter, without the owner's knowledge or consent.

On 2/21/08, at 2147 hrs, Officers responded to the area of 16210A Madison regarding a Robbery that occurred at LIN GARDEN. Dispatch advised they were trying to get further information, but there was a language barrier. Dispatch advised the suspect vehicle, a black SUV, left the area, possibly northbound on Woodward. When I arrived on scene, Officer Leanza was speaking with a few individuals attempting to get information. Other Officers were checking the area. We learned the following:

A couple of patrons, WIT/JERMIE BUDAY and WIT/ERIC HORAK, were standing in front of O'Donnell's Pub, 16204 Madison, when they observed a light skinned black male come running around the southeast corner of the building. The male slipped on the snow, and saw these males outside. BUDAY stated the male put his head down, had his hood over his head, and headed straight into CPY/LIN GARDEN. The next thing BUDAY and HORAK heard were the bells on the door to LIN GARDEN ring, and the owner of the store, VIC/LI, yelling. BUDAY and HORAK observed the suspect run out of the store towards Madison, and turned westbound onto Madison.

HORAK attempted to follow the male westbound on Madison, but lost sight of him. It was at this time he observed WIT/LAUREN HANSGEN. HANSGEN's told HORAK she saw the male get into a dark colored SUV, which drove off. HORAK obtained HANSGEN phone number and returned to the scene. The police were contacted at this time.

The male was described as a light skinned, black male, approximately 6'00", wearing a black puffy jacket that had brown fur around the hood. The male was also wearing something over his head, underneath the hood that came down to eyes.

I attempted to speak with LI regarding the incident, but there was a severe language barrier. LI could not speak, or understand, English. The only information I was able to obtain from LI was the suspect was a tall, black, male who came into the store waving his arms when he approached the counter and took the tip jar. LI yelled "police", then pointed to the tip jar, which was sitting on the counter, and acted out that the jar was dropped before the male exited the restaurant. LI was unable to tell me if any money was taken due to the fact he did not understand my questioning. There was still currency inside the jar.

I was able to contact HANSGEN by phone and learned the following:

HANSGEN stated she was in the process of parking her vehicle, on the eastside of Woodward just south of the parking lot to the north of 1675 Woodward, when she noticed a dark colored SUV or Truck sitting in the lot running. HANSGEN noticed this vehicle because she temporarily blocked the driveway while she was parking. HANSGEN observed a black male, a little shorter than 6'0", wearing all dark clothing with a hood pulled over his head, come running northbound on Woodward from Madison, and run towards the vehicle. HANSGEN is unsure if this male entered the driver's side or passenger side of the vehicle. As soon as the male reached the vehicle, it left the parking lot, turning southbound onto Woodward. HANSGEN did not notice if the vehicle continued southbound on Woodward or if it turned onto Madison. Just after the vehicle left, she was approached by HORAK.
