Topic Original Report

MO:By displaying a firearm during an attempted robbery.

Sgt. WYNALEK Sir;

Dispatched to the area of Revely/Madison on the report of a female being robbed at gunpoint. While enroute, dispatch advised that the incident happened several minutes ago and the suspects left S/B on Revely in a black auto, Ohio registration EDU7007. The vehicle was allegedly driven by a white female, and the suspect male was described as being black and wearing all dark clothing. Inv. MOHER, Sgt. B. WILKINS, and I checked the area with negative results. Officers responded to VIC/ARIELLE COOK'S residence, and located her walking W/B in the area. COOK advised the following:

She was walking E/B on Madison on the South side of the sidewalk. COOK said she was walking to the bus stop so she could catch the bus and go to work. As she was walking, she noticed the suspect male walking towards her W/B from the area of Walgreen's. COOK described the suspect as a black male, late teens, wearing a black, one-piece snowsuit type outfit and a black hat.

COOK said that as soon as the suspect passed her, he grabbed her left shoulder from behind and spun her around. COOK said that the suspect pulled her tight into his body, and at that time she noticed he was holding a gun. COOK described the gun as being small and black. She said it was not as large as the ones LPD carries, but she could provide no further description. COOK said that he gun was in the suspects left hand.

The male allegedly told COOK "Give me what you've got". COOK said that she began to scream and wave her arms, attempting to get someone's attention to help her. At that time, the suspect allegedly threw some type of liquid into COOK'S face and began to run away. The male got into the listed auto, which was parked running on Revely, just South of Madison. The auto then left S/B.

COOK said that she thought it was Pepsi that the male threw at her, because of the smell of it. It should be noted that when officers arrived, we observed a dark colored liquid that had been splashed onto COOK'S clothes, hair, and face. COOK could provide no description of the container that the liquid had been in. Officers checked the area, but found nothing of value.

COOK was not able to tell where the suspect vehicle came from. The only description of the driver she could provide was that it is a white female. Officers asked COOK to repeat the plate to make sure we had the right one, and she advised that she was positive that it was EBU7007. COOK described the vehicle as being a black HHR and new, possibly a '07 or '08. The listing comes back to OWN/PV HOLDING CORPORATION on a gray '08 Chevy.

COOK provided a written statement detailing the incident. She desires prosecution. COOK had no visible injuries, nor did she claim any. She advised that the only item of value she had in her possession at the time was \$20, which she still had in her possession. COOK said after the auto left the area, she began to walk back towards her apartment because she did not know where else to go. While walking, she took out her cell phone and called 911.
