M/O:By removing the copper pipe from the victims house without permission to do so.

Lt. Warner Sir,

On 03/13/08, at approximately 1853 hrs, I was detailed to 1453 Hopkins on a report from VIC/ROCKWELL CALVERT that someone had stolen copper pipe from his home.

CALVERT identified himself as the owner of the property at 1451/1453 Hopkins. The house is a two family home, with 1451 being the upstairs, and 1453 being the downstairs. CALVERT stated that at 2300 hrs, on 03/12/08, he received a voicemail from the tenant in 1451 Hopkins. CALVERT only knew the male as OIV/JAMES. CALVERT stated that JAMES' message stated that he needed to speak with CALVERT. When CALVERT called JAMES back on 03/13/08, he learned that someone had cut the copper pipes out of the basement of the home.

JAMES advised CALVERT that on 03/12/08, at approximately 1430 hrs, the former tenants of 1453 had come over to the house to get some of their property. JAMES stated that at this time, he left the house. When he returned later in the evening, he realized that he had no hot water. JAMES went into the basement and found water running all over from where the pipes had been cut. JAMES turned off the water and called CALVERT, leaving him a message.

CALVERT advised that he had recently evicted the tenants of 1453, and they were supposed to out of the house by 03/09/08. CALVERT stated that he only knew them as "DESTINY" and "PACO". CALVERT advised that the two had moved in approximately 3 months ago. At the time, they gave CALVERT \$1200.00 for a security deposit. CALVERT stated that they never filled out the proper rental paperwork, and never gave him any money for rent, so he evicted them. CALVERT was only able to give me a cell phone number for "PACO". He also stated that "PACO" drove a white, two door vehicle with "big rims". CALVERT described "DESTINY" as an 18 year old B/F.

CALVERT led me to the basement, through a common rear door. CALVERT stated that this door is always locked, however he found it open today. There were no signs of force to the rear door.

The pipes had been removed from both water heaters. One of the pipes had been cut with a pipe cutter, and the other had been snapped off.

The suspects had removed all the copper pipes, except the ones secured to the floor joists. The pipes leading from the ceiling to the two washing machines had been snapped off, and pulled free from the brackets that had been securing them to the walls. IVN. ALLEN photographed the broken pipe joints, as well as the tops of the two water heaters.

No damage was caused by the water running into the basement after the pipes had been removed.

CALVERT and I went through some of the bags of garbage that "DESTINY" and "PACO" had left behind. The name SUS/PATRICE WATSON was found on several items. Dispatch located the listed information on WATSON.
