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Topic Original Report

M.O.: By taking 3 packs of cigarettes from the listed business without the owners consent and using force against the manager while fleeing the store

LT Sprague, Sir,

Detailed with PTL PIETCH to Madison Bi-Rite, 12503 Madison on 3/14/2008 at 1037hrs on the report of a shoplifter trying to exit the store. Prior to arriving, dispatch advised that the suspect was struggling with employees and that the store manager had locked the store so that the suspected shoplifter could not exit. I arrived and was granted access by the manager, VIC/JYOTI PATEL.

PATEL pointed out the suspect, later identified as ARA/AMANDA LYNN, near the entrance to the store. PATEL advised that she was counting money in the manager's station when she noticed a customer standing near a cigarette display. The display is in close proximity to the manager's station. PATEL checked the camera concentrated on that cigarette display and observed LYNN selecting three packs of cigarettes. As LYNN walked away, another camera observed LYNN concealing the cigarettes in her jacket. PATEL followed LYNN throughout the store and into the checkout line. LYNN purchased a small amount of food products prior to leaving the store, but did not attempt to pay for the cigarettes.

PATEL approached LYNN at the register and asked her to pay for the cigarettes or leave them at the counter. LYNN denied taking the cigarettes and attempted to leave the store. PATEL had an employee call LPD at that time. PATEL tried to grab LYNN to stop her. LYNN pushed at PATEL'S face and continued struggling to leave the store. An employee locked the door so that LYNN could not leave. LYNN kicked PATEL twice and did not stop struggling until she pushed at the door and realized it was locked. LPD arrived moments later. PATEL advised that the store's video cameras are in working order and recorded the incident.

LYNN was not hostile when I arrived on scene. She was visibly upset and claimed not to have stolen anything. LYNN repeatedly attempted to reach into her jacket while I was speaking with her. I asked LYNN to remove the jacket and give it to me. LYNN complied. A large bulge was apparent in the jacket. The three packs of listed cigarettes were located in her right front jacket pocket.

After I pulled the items from the jacket, LYNN stated that she had stolen the cigarettes and struggled with PATEL in an attempt to get away. LYNN advised that she did so because she was scared and had never been in trouble before. LYNN advised that she had stolen the cigarettes because her family has had "money problems." INV KULCZYCKI was detailed for pictures. PATEL took possession back of the cigarettes.

PTL PIETCH stayed with LYNN while I went to the manager's station to review the video with PATEL. The video clearly showed the incident as described. PATEL advised that a copy of the video would be made available to LPD sometime on the day of this report. PATEL advised that she would prosecute LYNN for robbery.

LYNN was transported to LPD by this officer in unit # 207. LYNN was booked by CO BUNNER and
