Topic Original Report

M.O.: By entering an apartment through an unlocked front door and taking video game equipment without the owner's consent

LT Sprague, Sir,

Detailed to 12405 Detroit #14 on 3/19/2008 at 1520hrs on the report of a burglary. Arrived and spoke with VIC/SHAVONIA MOORE.

MOORE advised that she left her apartment at about 1230hrs and went to the food bank on Marlowe/Detroit on the day of this report. She returned to the apartment at about 1430hrs and noticed the listed Microsoft Xbox and 5 listed Xbox video games missing. The game system was left on top of a T.V. in the living room, with the games on a shelf nearby. Nothing else in the apartment was missing or disturbed.

No signs of forced entry were found. MOORE advised that she locked the doorknob on the front door when she left, but left the deadbolt unlocked. I checked the doorknob and discovered that the lock was inoperative. It did not appear tampered with. MOORE advised that she did not know that the lock did not work.

MOORE does not know who could have committed the burglary. MOORE advised that many people enter and exit the apartment on a daily basis. MOORE lives with her boyfriend and a female roommate, both of which have people over regularly that MOORE does not know. MOORE advised that she had not yet spoken with her roommates about the incident, but stated that she knows they had nothing to do with the missing video game. She did not disclose the identities of her roommates. MOORE stated that "everybody" plays the video games when they come over. MOORE claims to have the only key to the apartment. When asked how the other residents get in the door if she is not home, MOORE advised that she would have to leave the door unlocked. E.T. was not requested due to the above factors. MOORE was advised of the low solvability of the incident. MOORE will prosecute.

In running MOORE through CRIS, it was discovered that she had a warrant with GOV/ASHTABULA COUNTY S.O. for cocaine possession and complicity. SGT Allen at ACSO confirmed the warrant. MOORE was placed in unit # 215 and transported to LPD by this officer. MOORE was booked by CO McCarthy and DISP Florjancic for holding while awaiting transfer to ACSO.
