**Topic** Original Report

MO-By entering the locked residence and taking copper piping from the home without permission to do so.

Detailed on 3-24-08 at about 1114 Hrs. to 1600 Cohasset Ave. on the report of copper piping stolen from the home over the weekend. Inv. Walling arrived to assist. On Officers arrival we spoke with VIC/TIMOTHY BOWEN who advised the following.

BOWEN stated that he bought the home several months ago as a complete remodel. Since that time BOWEN has been spending him free time at night and on the weekends doing work on the home himself. BOWEN stated he was last at the home the evening of 3-21-08. BOWEN left the home secured at around 2000 Hrs. that date.

On his return this date, BOWEN found that someone had broken in and stolen most of the copper piping from the basement. BOWEN then called LPD for a report. BOWEN stated he knew something was wrong as the front door for the home was found closed but unlocked on his arrival.

In checking the home, the point of entry was determined to be the north westernmost basement window. The suspects were somehow able to force open this window (no damage) and the suspect(s) entered the home there. The point of exit was the front door. It appears that the suspect(s) may have tried to leave through the back door but were unable to as it had been secured into the frame by some screws.

It should be noted that a number of new pieces of copper were overlooked by the suspects. Also, a number of BOWEN's power tools which had been left on site were not tampered with. None appeared to be missing at the time of the report.

It should be noted that heavy snowfall occurred on 3-22-08. However, no tire tracks were observed in the driveway at the home and none of the footprints surrounding the home appeared to be of any evidentiary value. Also, no signs in the yard at the time of report advertising the home as either for sale or rent.

BOWEN was advised on the report and given the report number for his records. BOWEN was advised on the solvability. In checking with the neighbors, there was no answer at 1595, 1597, 1601, 1604, and 1605 Cohasset. The residents I did speak with at 1596 and 1603 Cohasset stated they did not see anyone suspicious at the home over the weekend.
