<p>MO: By forcing side, common door of double, vacant house, entering same, cutting and removing copper piping from basement</p> <p>On 3-27-08 at 1610Hrs. I was detailed to 2102 Clarence on the report of copper piping being cut and stolen from a vacant house.</p> <p>On arrival I spoke with COM/LISA PIORKOWSKI who explained that she received an e-mail yesterday from a coworker, Dave Rubin, stating that on 3-24-08, he discovered the side door of 2102 Clarence forced open and copper piping missing from the basement. He then advised her that he was going on vacation and requested that PIORKOWSKI make a report with our department.</p> <p>PIORKOWSKI stated that she had not entered the home yet and had never been there before. She unlocked a lock box from a hasp that was securing the side, common door for us to gain entry. PIORKOWSKI advised that Mr. Rubin installed this after finding the door handle with lock removed.</p> <p>She had no further information for Mr. Rubin.</p> <p>PIORKOWSKI stated that she had just started working for the company. She did not get any indication from Mr. Rubin as to what time frame the incident may have occurred during.</p> <p>Upon checking the home I found small portions of copper piping left with cutting marks. The piping had been cut from close to the water meter towards the other end of the basement leading to two hot water tanks. It appeared that about two hundred feet of copper piping was taken.</p> <p>INV. Allen later responded for ET work. He took photos and found no latents.</p> <p>PIORKOWSKI was advised of the low solvability factor of this report. She understood and stated that</p>
