that she drove him to OLIVER's house and she then dropped him and OLIVER off at Giant Eagle.

In running RADU, he was found to have an active warrant out of GOV/PARMA HTS. P.D. The warrant was for Theft By Deception and was later confirmed by HUDAK who placed a holder.

RADU was secured in handcuffs and searched. RADU initially denied knowing anything about the coins stating that he knew what his rights were and wanted a lawyer. No other questions were asked. RADU then began volunteering more information and agreed to speak with officers. He still claimed that he had been dropped off with OLIVER and knew nothing about the coins.

OLIVER stated again that the coins belonged COOK and told officers where he worked so that we could attempt to contact him and verify her story.

INV. ALLEN was requested to assist.

P.O. LEANZA was eventually able to speak with COOK on the telephone. COOK advised that on 03/20/08 he "bailed OLIVER out of jail." He stated that he had been letting her stay at his house because she needed somewhere "safe to stay." P.O. LEANZA described the coins, that OLIVER had, to COOK. COOK stated that his father, who had recently passed away, had a large coin collection which consisted of the coins that OLIVER had. COOK stated that the coins now belonged to him and OLIVER did not have permission to have them and/or sell them. COOK advised that he wanted to prosecute OLIVER and RADU and was willing to give us a statement. COOK also advised that he was leaving work and responding to our location.

OLIVER was advised that she was under arrest and secured in handcuffs. She became irate and stated that officers had lied to COOK about what had happened accusing us of trying to ruin her life.

OLIVER now stated that some of the coins belonged to RADU which he denied.

In searching OLIVER'S purse, incident to her arrest, I located three men's rings. OLIVER stated that the rings also belonged to COOK and that she had put them in her purse so that RADU would not steal them from the house. I also located the listed cap for a hypodermic needle in her purse. She stated that it belonged to RADU. She then looked at RADU and said "tell them what you are!" I took the cap as evidence.

OLIVER also had all of the listed US currency in her purse including two \$2.00 bills and a Brazillian \$1.00 bill.

OLIVER and RADU were then secured in police vehicles. Both denied having driven a vehicle to the store. At the time of his arrest, RADU had an ignition key for a Cadillac in his possession.

At this point COOK arrived. He advised that OLIVER was not his girlfriend as she had claimed. He identified the rings as once belonging to his father and now him.

COOK stated that he knew RADU as a friend of OLIVER's. COOK stated that RADU drove a tan Cadillac Catrera that was missing its rear bumper. INV. ALLEN located the listed vehicle in the parking lot. The vehicle was parked in the first spot just outside the exit door.

A tow was ordered for the vehicle. INV. ALLEN began an inventory of it's interior. He located the two listed firearms in an ammunition can, which was on the passenger floorboard. He also located several more coins under the driver's seat. There were 13-J.F.K 50 cent pieces, and 7-\$1.00 coins under the seat. The coins were wrapped up in a rag. The firearms and coins were taken as evidence. The vehicle was then towed to Kufner's.

P.O. HARNER transported OLIVER to LPD jail where he booked her in along with P.O. RUSNAK and DISP. MALLOY. Per policy, due to recent drug arrests and the fact that OLIVER appeared to be under the influence of narcotics, a strip search was performed with no other contraband being located.

I transported RADU to LPD jail. While waiting to book him, RADU advised the following: He had been at COOK's house for about 30 minutes on today's date. He stated that he "felt like something wasn't right," so he called a friend. He told the friend to call him back and make up some kind of an emergency so that he could leave the house. RADU never left the house and stated that he later decided to drive OLIVER to Giant Eagle. He could not explain why he had gone through the trouble of making up an emergency and then not leaving the house.

When asked about the firearms in the vehicle, he stated that he knew nothing about them. He stated that OLIVER had carried some boxes out to the vehicle. He stated that he wasn't paying attention and could not describe the boxes.

RADU stated that the vehicle belonged to a friend named "PAM." RADU gave me the phone number (216) for her. She was later contacted and identified as OWN/PAMELA SWIETYNIOWSKI. SWIETYNIOWSKI advised that she knew RADU through a male named "TINY". She stated that her daughter recently gave her the vehicle and she is in the process of having the title transferred. She stated that on 03/25/08, RADU came to her house to take the vehicle so that he could fix it. SWIETYNIOWSKI stated that the vehicle would not start and that RADU was eventually able to get it running. She stated that he was then supposed to drive it to "TINY's" to work on it. She stated that she had not given RADU permission to be driving the vehicle elsewhere. She was advised on the process of retrieving the vehicle.

SWIETYNIOWSKI also stated that she does not own any firearms and did not know why they were in the vehicle.

INV. ALLEN followed COOK to his house. He photographed all of the coins, rings, the firearms and released them to COOK. He and COOK then checked the home to see if anything else had been taken. INV. ALLEN located several drug pipes, hypodermic needles, two heroin kits, and several empty baggies which contained heroin residue. He took these items as evidence. He later tagged them and secured them in the chute in the LPD property room.

INV. ALLEN obtained a written statement from COOK.

I later tagged the hypodermic needle cap, and secured it in the chute in the LPD property room.

Prior to being detained by P.O. LEANZA and I, OLIVER was able to get an unknown amount of the stolen money into the Coin-Star machine. Store employees printed out the two listed receipts, which

totalled \$113.72. INV. ALLEN photographed and tagged the receipts. They were then released to COOK so that he could contact Coin-Star and attempt to retrieve the money.

Both OLIVER and RADU have CCH's.

OLIVER has FBI#852761XB4 and BCI#C121466. She has prior arrests for felony drugs and probation violations.

RADU has FBI# [REDACTED] and BCI# [REDACTED]. He has prior arrests for DV, felony drugs, B&E, and probation violations.

In running the listed Smith & Wesson through LEADS, it came back entered through White Plains, NY. Even though the serial # matched that of the entry there was an inconsistency when it came to the caliber. The entering agency was contacted and they confirmed it as stolen but additional follow-up would have to be conducted through their Detective Bureau. They were told to contact Sgt. DONAHUE. See attached printout. It should be noted that COOK was cooperative throughout this preliminary investigation.
