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

<p>MO; By pushing in northeast basement window using physical force, entering home, pulling copper partially down from basement ceiling, partially cutting one section of copper pipe on both ends, without owners permission.</p> <p>Detailed to 1601 Olivewood on the report of a vacant home entered and it appears some copper plumbing was damaged. On arrival, I spoke with COM/MICHAEL MCGINTY, who said his son, VIC/PATRICK MCGINTY, owns the home.</p> <p>MICHAEL said he has been working on the vacant home for awhile now and was just in the home on 4-1-08 at 1630 hrs. MICHAEL said he arrived at the home today, came through the front door and heard water running downstairs in the basement. MICHAEL said he checked the basement, noticed the northeast copper plumbing was partially pulled down and water was leaking out of some of the copper pipe/fittings. MICHAEL said he shut off the water and called LPD.</p> <p>In checking the home, it appears the suspect(s) pushed in the northeast basement window using physical force (one nail securing the window shut in a partially rotted frame). The suspect(s) then started pulling down a large section of copper pipe by physical force. Then the suspect(s) partially cut opposite ends of another section of copper pipe but it was still connected to the basement ceiling. It is unknown why the suspect(s) did not remove any copper plumbing from the home.</p> <p>The suspect(s) left out the back door and left it unlocked. No other damage was done to the home. MICHAEL has no suspect(s). I advised MICHAEL of the low solvability factors of this report. However, MICHAEL said if a suspect(s) were located PATRICK would prosecute in this matter.</p> <p>I knocked on 1597 and 1603 (vacant) Olivewood and nobody was home. 1596 (vacant) and 1602 Olivewood and nobody was home. I spoke with TERRY GLOVER at 1600 Olivewood, he said he did not hear or see anything unusual.</p> <p>At LPD, I phoned PATRICK, advised him that a police report was made by his father, MICHAEL, in regards to his rental property. PATRICK said MICHAEL had called him and was aware of this incident. I advised PATRICK that MICHAEL was securing all the windows prior to leaving his home today.</p> <p>CC; Building Dept. ✓</p>
