Topic Original Report

MO; By pulling down horizontal casement window by unknown means, breaking it off hinges, entering through window, taking listed property, and damaging some copper pipe without owners permission.

On 4-3-08 at 1555 hrs., I was detailed to 1612 Lincoln on the report of a Burglary. On arrival, I spoke with VIC/JASON TAYLOR and VIC/AMY GALLAGHER. TAYLOR said they both left for work together this morning and just arrived home this afternoon together. TAYLOR said they found the side door unlocked and entered their home.

TAYLOR said they noticed the first floor west kitchen window broken out and left on the ground below the window housing. TAYLOR said they checked the rest of the home and noticed the following items stolen. TAYLOR said the southwest, second floor gaming room was entered. The X-Box 360 was taken off of an entertainment center and about thirty CD's were removed from three CD holders.

TAYLOR said the northeast, second floor gaming room had a Play Station II stolen from it. Nothing else was missing from that room.

TAYLOR said one long section of copper plumbing was pulled slightly down from the basement ceiling but not damaged. TAYLOR had a copper run off pipe pulled off of his furnace and bent into pieces. This piece was approximately four feet long and left on the basement floor.

TAYLOR said nothing else was damaged or stolen.

TAYLOR said he thinks his neighbor, SUS/PAUL KRUMPHANZEL may have done this. TAYLOR said KRUMPHANZEL is a "Druggie and steals." TAYLOR said he has lived next to KRUMPHANZEL for a long time and said he is always getting arrested for stealing and drugs.

TAYLOR said he was really upset when he noticed his home was entered and he said he phoned KRUMPHANZEL. TAYLOR said he briefly spoke with KRUMPHANZEL and told him his home was Burglarized and to watch his home. TAYLOR said he intended to accuse him of breaking into his home but did not. TAYLOR said he then hung up the phone. TAYLOR said KRUMPHANZEL left his home prior to my arrival in a dark Lincoln auto.

I knocked on the following addresses to obtain additional data. 1607, 1611, 1615 Lincoln and all residents said they had just come home and did not see anything. 1616 and 1608 Lincoln were checked and nobody answered the door.

TAYLOR and GALLAGHER said they will prosecute in this matter.

I phoned The Exchange here in Lakewood, Ohio and they advised me that none of the my listed items were traded in there today.

TAYLOR and GALLAGHER did not know what CD's were stolen as they have so many and they will have to sort through their collection to figure out what was stolen. I gave them the report number and advised them to drop off the list as soon as they complete it.
