Topic Original Report

MO: By physically restraining, striking, and attempting to take the property of the victim without his consent.

Sgt. Wilkins, Sir:

On 4/4/2008, at approximately 1440 hours, PO Zbydnowski and I were detailed to the vicinity of Clifton Place and Detroit on the report of an attempted robbery. We checked the surrounding area for the suspects (SUS/ UNKNOWN 1-one black male, approximately 6'2, wearing a grey hoodie and SUS/ UNKNOWN 2-one white male, approximately 5'8, wearing a black hoodie, with a green circle) with negative results. We then met VIC/ CHARLES SPENCER at the corner of Clifton Place and Detroit. He advised the following.

At approximately 1435 hours, SPENCER left Simones Beverage after purchasing cigarettes. He began walking towards his home at _____, East bound on Detroit, on the South side of the road. While in the vicinity of West Clifton and Detroit he noticed the listed suspects walking just West of him. When he was near the South East corner of Clifton Place and Detroit, approximately 15 feet from the intersection, SUSPECT 1 asked SPENCER for a cigarette. SPENCER reached into his pocket to retrieve a cigarette. SUSPECT 1 reached around SPENCER and grabbed his arms. SUSPECT 1 held SPENCER's arms behind him so that he could not move or defend himself. SUSPECT 2 then punched SPENCER in the right eye. SPENCER was able to twist away from SUSPECT 1 and strike him in the face with a closed fist. SUSPECT 2 attempted to reach into SPENCER's pocket at this time and asked him "what do you have?". SPENCER then began to yell for help. Immediately after this, SUSPECT 1 ran away from SPENCER Westbound on Detroit, then heading South on West Clifton. SUSPECT 2 ran away from the scene South on Clifton Place. SPENCER did not pursue these suspects from the scene. SPENCER immediately contacted LPD via cell phone and supplied dispatch with the above-referenced descriptions of the suspects.

Additional units in the area checked for the listed suspects with negative results. The area of the incident was also checked for evidence with negative results.

SPENCER sustained a large contusion to his left cheek, just under his eye. He advised that he did not require medical attention for his injury. Inv. MOHER responded to the scene and took photos of SPENCER's injury.

SPENCER provided a written statement documenting this incident as well. He advised that the suspect's involved in the incident wore hooded jackets. He stated that the hoods covered their hair and partially covered their faces. However, he would still be able to identify the suspects. SPENCER provided the following information in addition to the initial report to dispatch regarding the suspects.

SUSPECT 1 had a goatee. His upper lip appeared to have a scar on it that was not covered by hair. He indicated that this black male appeared to be in his early to mid 20's. He also reported that the male had a medium to muscular build. He indicated that the suspect had no visible tattoos or scars. The suspect did not have a noticeable accent or speech impediment.

SUSPECT 2 had no facial hair. He had a medium build and also appeared to be in early to mid

twenties. He had no visible scars or tattoos. The suspect did not have a noticeable accent or speech impediment.

It may be noted that while interviewing SPENCER a moderate odor of an alcoholic beverage could be detected. SPENCER did not appear to show any signs of intoxication. SPENCER advised that he desires prosecution should the suspects be located.

Officer Zbydnowski and I checked neighboring businesses, Bread Smith and Donatos, to determine if any witnesses were available. No witnesses were found. Two bars, The Kenilworth and Put-In-Bay, were also checked to see if SPENCER, SUSPECT 1 or SUSPECT 2 were seen in the area or establishments. No witnesses could be located. Simones Beverage was also checked to see if the suspects or SPENCER were seen in the establishment. No employees reported seeing any of the suspects or SPENCER in the business at any time today.
