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

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Topic Original Report

M/O#1:By being in possession of 8 Adderall pills, a schedule 2 narcotic.

M/O#2:By being in possession of .04 grams of crack cocaine.

M/O#3:By being in possession of 1.0 grams of marijuana.

Lt. Warner Sir,

On 04/06/08, at approximately 2026 hrs, I was W/B on Franklin passing Winchester. I observed the listed vehicle parked across from 1530 Winchester. I observed 2 males, later identified as ARA/JEREMY PARKS and ARA/DENNY STRAWSER, approach the vehicle from 1530. I was unable to read the license plate on the vehicle, but observed that it was a gold Chevrolet station wagon. I turned N/B onto Ridgewood and proceeded to Detroit. The vehicle was stopped on Winchester at Detroit. As I passed the vehicle, I observed that the windshield was badly cracked.

As I was waiting for a red light at Detroit and W117th, the vehicle pulled along side me and I could hear that the exhaust on the vehicle was abnormally loud. I stopped the vehicle on Detroit at W114th. PARKS was driving, and was advised of the reason for the stop. STRAWSER was the only passenger, and was sitting in the front seat.

PARKS appeared slightly nervous. At first he would not look at me or speak to me. When he handed me his drivers license, his hands was shaking. I asked PARKS where he was coming from and he said his friend "NICK'S" house on Beach. He stated that he and STRAWSER had been there "Chillin".

P.O. GREEAR arrived to assist, and I had PARKS exit the vehicle. I asked PARKS if there was anything illegal in the vehicle. He stated that there was not, and gave officers consent to search the vehicle and his person. I initially did not locate any contraband on PARKS' person. I then had STRAWSER exit the vehicle. He also consented to a search of his person, with no contraband being found.

In searching the vehicle, I located a cigarette box wrapper with marijuana inside of it. This was in a cup holder in the center console, underneath an empty can of pop.

Inside the center console, I located a plastic baggie with 7 blue pills inside it. I also located one loose pill, in the bottom of the console. The pills in the baggie were packaged tightly, with the rest of the baggie having been torn off. I located the rest of the baggie in the console. In checking the pills, they read "ADDERALL XR 10MG". SGT. KAUCHECK also arrived to assist at this point.

After it was determined that the pills were a schedule 2 narcotic, both PARKS and STRAWSER were secured in handcuffs and advised of their Miranda Rights. Both stated that they understood their rights.

PARKS stated that the pills belonged to his cousin, later identified as OIV/ . He stated that he did not know why the pills were in his vehicle, but that was in the vehicle earlier and must have left them there. He could not explain why they were packaged in the manner that

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they were.

STRAWSER stated that [redacted] was his step-son, and was prescribed the pills for ADHD. STRAWSER stated that [redacted] was at home with his mother, OIV/HEATHER BASKERVILLE, and provided me with a phone number to contact HEATHER.

In speaking with HEATHER, she stated that [redacted] is indeed prescribed the pills for ADHD. She stated that PARKS and STRAWSER had left the house some time ago. She stated that they were supposed to be going to the pharmacy to fill an ADDERALL prescription for [redacted]. She further stated that she was wondering what had taken them so long, as she was waiting for them to return so that she could go pick up dinner.

PARKS and STRAWSER were advised that they were both under arrest for Drug Abuse.

I then searched them more thoroughly. In searching PARKS, I located a small rock of what appeared to crack cocaine in his right front pants pocket. There was also a small piece of a plastic baggie in his pocket. PARKS initially stated that he did not know what the substance was.

I again asked PARKS where he had been. He again stated that he was at "NICK'S" house, but this time stated that "NICK" lived on Winchester. PARKS stated that he and STRAWSER had gone over there and watched a movie. When asked, PARKS stated that he could not remember the name of the movie or what it was about. He stated that he had fallen asleep and not watched the movie. He then stated that they had only been at "NICK'S" house for 20 minutes. He was then secured in the rear of unit #207.

No further contraband was located on STRAWSER. STRAWSER became agitated, and would not answer any more questions. He was secured in the rear of unit #212.


Officers then checked the vehicle again, but found no further contraband. The vehicle was then towed to Kufner's.

P.O. GREEAR transported STRAWSER to LPD jail. STRAWSER was booked in by P.O. GREEAR, P.O. RUSNAK and C.O. MCCARTHY. Per policy, a strip search was performed with no other contraband being located.

I transported PARKS to LPD jail. While waiting to book PARKS, I spoke with him further. He admitted that what I had found in his pocket was crack cocaine. He stated that the marijuana was also his. PARKS stated that he had recently begun "experimenting" with crack, and usually mixes it with his marijuana. PARKS stated that he was unaware the crack was in his pocket, otherwise he would have "smoked it". I asked PARKS about what HEATHER had told me concerning him and STRAWSER filling a prescription for [redacted] on today's date. PARKS stated that he knew nothing about that.

P.O. RUSNAK, C.O. MCCARTHY, and I then booked PARKS in. Per policy, a strip search was performed with no other contraband being located.

I weighed the crack cocaine and found there to be 0.04 grams. I then tested the crack and received a positive result. I weighed the marijuana and found there to be a total of 1.0 grams.

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I then tagged the Adderall, crack, and marijuana, and secured all of it in the chute in the LPD property room.

PARKS had no CCH, and a SNS shows no prior arrests.

STRAWSER has a CCH. He has FBI# _____ and BCI# _____. He shows arrests for Trafficking, Felony Drug Abuse, and GTMV.
