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Topic Original Report

MO- By having a clear plastic baggie containing 1.0G of Cocaine in the small front pocket of her jeans
 MO- By having in the cellophane wrapper of a pack of cigarettes in her vehicle, a generic Percocet pill, a Schedule II drug without a prescription
 MO- By having a in a coin purse in her backpack, a light blue ceramic pipe with burnt residue commonly used to smoke marijuana

On 04/12/2008 I ran a random registration check on the listed Ford as it traveled in front of me Northbound on W117TH from FRANKLIN. The vehicle was in the left lane initially, and I believed it may turn into Lakewood. The vehicle moved into the curb lane near DETROIT, then turned Eastbound onto CLIFTON when the plate came back. The vehicle owner, (ARA)WILLIAMSON, came back suspended. I continued Northbound on W117TH to EDGEWATER, where I headed Westbound and began checking for parking violations.

As I neared COVE, I observed the Ford traveling Eastbound towards me. I confirmed the plate was the same one I had run moments earlier. As the vehicle passed me, I observed that the driver appeared to match the physical description for WILLIAMSON. I turned around and initiated a traffic stop as the vehicle pulled into the driveway for the Berkshire at 11820 EDGEWATER.

The operator produced her OL identifying her as WILLIAMSON. She was informed of the reason for the stop. WILLIAMSON said she was driving to a friend's residence, and not due to any emergency. WILLIAMSON was found to be under a License Forfeiture suspension 04/03/2008-Indefinite. A fee is required.

WILLIAMSON was issued Citation #D161539 for DUS and advised of her court date. I then informed her that her vehicle would be impounded. I asked if she had any items I needed to know about in her vehicle, and specifically mentioned drugs. She said she did not. During my inventory of the vehicle, I located a multi-colored coin purse inside WILLIAMSON's open backpack on the front seat. Inside the coin purse was a light blue drug pipe with burnt residue and a total of 3 clear baggies; 2 of the baggies were situated 1 inside the other, and the other was separate.

I asked WILLIAMSON if she had anything else on her person and she said no. During a search of her person incident to arrest, I located a clear baggie containing a white powder I suspected to be Cocaine in the right front small pocket of her jeans. WILLIAMSON was then handcuffed and advised she was under arrest for Felony Drug Abuse.

WILLIAMSON was secured in PTL. LEANZA's cruiser, 205. I read her Miranda Warnings to her while PTL. LEANZA continued the inventory of the car. WILLIAMSON indicated she understood her rights. She was asked if the white powder would test positive for Cocaine, and she said she believed it would. She admitted that she was taking it from one friend's residence to another friend. WILLIAMSON had been smoking when stopped and was about to light up another cigarette when I had her step out of the vehicle to explain the Citation to her initially. After she was handcuffed, I detected an odor of alcoholic beverage about her person. I spoke to her throughout the stop and did not feel that she had consumed enough alcoholic beverage to be impaired.

PTL. LEANZA located a white pill inside the cellophane wrapper of a pack of Marlboro Lights cigarettes.

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The pill had "512" on 1 side and a vertical line on the other. The cigarette pack was in a jacket pocket on the back seat of the vehicle. I placed the items located in the car and on WILLIAMSON in my cruiser; 220.

PTL. LEANZA and CO. BUNNER transported WILLIAMSON to the station. Kufner Towing responded and towed the Ford. It will be held for WILLIAMSON and a licensed driver.

At the station, I gave the pill in the cigarette pack to PTL. LEANZA. He then transported it to WALGREENS, where the pharmacist identified it as a generic form of Percocet; a schedule II drug.

WILLIAMSON was booked in by PTL. DENNIS MCCARTHY and DISP. DIBACCO. A strip search was conducted to insure the safety and security of the jail and nothing was located.

The suspected Cocaine field tested positive for Cocaine using a Narkit Jr. I tagged the Cocaine, Percocet and cigarette pack, drug pipe, and marijuana and coin purse and placed each item in a clear evidence bag. The items were then placed down the drug chute in LPD's property room. Note that the 2 baggies of marijuana situated 1 inside the other contained .92G of marijuana, while the other baggie contained 2.01G.

WILLIAMSON's OL was confiscated and later tagged to be sent back to the BMV.

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
