Topic Original Report

MO/ By pushing in a window air conditioner unit to gain entry into an apartment and taking property of value from apartment without permission.

On 4-16-08, at 2023 hours, I was detailed to 1416 Ridgewood #1 on a report of a burglary. On arrival I was met by VIC/DOWELL. DOWELL came home to find the front door of his apartment wide open. He looked around the apartment and found some of the rooms ransacked. He called LPD to report the incident.

In checking the apartment I found the front door open. There was no sign of forced entry to the door. The backdoor was still locked. The front door leads into a living room. Nothing was disturbed in the living room. A hallway ran west off the living room. The first room on the right down the hall was a bedroom. The room had been ransacked. Dresser drawers were opened and the contents were spilled on the floor. Items had been knocked off of shelves. A second bedroom was West of the first. It was found in the same condition as the first. The kitchen was West of both bedrooms. Nothing in the kitchen appeared disturbed.

I had DOWELL look through the rooms to see if he could find anything missing. He stated the indexed computer monitor was missing from the first bedroom. The tower and the other parts of his computer were still plugged in. DOWELL added that the window air conditioning unit was removed from the window and was on the floor a few feet from the window. The frame around the ACU was bent indicating it was forced from the window. It appeared that the ACU was pushed in from the outside and the bedroom window was the entry point. DOWELL checked the second bedroom and found nothing missing.

INV REGISTER responded for ET. He took photos of the scene. NOV was found.

DOWELL advised the other units in the building were empty, except unit 4. I knocked on the door at unit 4 and was unable to get an answer.

DOWELL advised he would prosecute. He had no suspects. He was advised of the low solvability factor.
