Topic Original Report

MO: By attempting to gain entry into the victim's beach house without his permission.

Sgt. WILKINS Ma'am;

Dispatched to the area of 14914 Edgewater Drive on the report of the male resident finding someone trying to break into his house. Dispatch advised that the call came through CECOMS and that the complainant was chasing the males through the parking lot of the Lakewood Catholic Academy. The complainant then hung up the phone as officers were responding to the area.

VIC/ALI SHAIKK eventually called back and advised that he was chasing the males through Lakewood Park. I met SHAIKK at the entrance to Lakewood Park and he advised that he lost sight of the males. He described them both as being both W/M's in their early teens. One was described as wearing a red and white shirt with some type of star logo on it and the other was described as wearing a black "jersey" type shirt.

Officers continued to check the area when Ptl. RUSNAK located two males matching the description walking E/B on the north sidewalk of Lake near the entrance to Lakewood Park. Ptl. RUSNAK secured ARJ/. It should be noted that this male was wearing a red/white shirt with various logos on it.

The second male, eventually identified as ARJ/, continued walking E/B on Lake. Ptl. ZBYDNOWSKI and I approached and he went to his knees placing his hands in the air. Ptl. ZBYDNOWSKI secured in handcuffs and placed him in the back of car 206. was wearing a baggy black t-shirt.

SHAIKK, who had been standing at the entrance of the park, positively identified both and as the males who had tried to break into his beach house. He advised that he desires prosecution. Inv. GEARY and I responded to SHAIKK's residence with him to learn further about the incident.

SHAIKK advised that he was walking to the rear of his house to do some yard work. While he was in his backyard, he noticed the two males standing down by his beach house. SHAIKK went down the stairs in his backyard, that lead to the beach house, to confront the males. Both were observed facing the southern most door to the building when SHAIKK confronted them.

SHAIKK said they were standing close to the door, but he could not tell if they were pulling on the handle in an attempt to gain entry. SHAIKK said that when he asked the boys what they were doing, they claimed to be looking for a ball that they had lost. It should be noted that the only way to access SHAIKK's beach house is either through his back yard or by walking along the beach and going up the stairs to the house.

The beach house is furnished but not frequently used. However, SHAIKK spoke of previous damage that had been done to his house that he wanted to tell me about. Noted was white spray paint on the inside of the windows with various letters and designs. Most were illegible, but one said "RIP" and one said "White Boy." Some of the furniture had been thrown around the interior, and some of the

wall decorations had been taken down and broken on the tile floor in front of the fireplace. SHAIKK said the damage happened sometime between January '08 and four days ago. He said he did not contact LPD because he didn't have any suspects. Even though the parties who had caused damage to the beach house previously had been arrested, he never received any restitution for the damage. SHAIKK felt it was a waste of time to contact LPD.

SHAIKK said he has had multiple problems the past few years with damage to the beach house and people breaking into it. He feels that _____ and _____ were going to cause further damage should they have gotten inside. After claiming they were looking for a lost ball, _____ and _____ fled E/B on the beach and up the walkway to Lakewood Park. SHAIKK got in his vehicle to follow them and saw them run N/B through the LCA parking lot. He last saw them E/B through the park just prior to stopping to speak with me.

Ptl. RUSNAK transported _____ to LPD. He was booked in by Ptl. LOWTHER and CO BUNNER for Attempted Breaking and Entering. Ptl. ZBYDNOWSKI transported _____ to LPD and he and CO BUNNER booked _____ for the same charge. It should be noted that both _____ and _____ stated that _____ spent the night at _____'s house last night and that they smoked marijuana together. Nothing illegal was found on either juvenile. Both juveniles were later released to their parents. It should be noted that neither of the ARJs were going to be admitted into the DH for the above listed charge.
