Topic Original Report

M.O. By stating he had a gun and taking \$300.00 dollars from victim

On 4-21-08, at 1622 hours, cars were detailed to the area of 1470 Warren on report from VIC/DAWN OSBORNE that she was robbed while walking on the sidewalk just north of the Lakewood Board of Education from Warren to Victoria. OSBORNE was not able to initially provide any suspect description other than it was a male and he said he had a gun. OSBORNE advised the incident happened a half hour to 45 minutes ago.

Upon speaking to OSBORNE at her home, she was visibly upset, crying and began hyperventilating. OSBORNE was visibly distressed and could barely speak to officers. OSBORNE advised she was shopping at Pet's Supplies Plus and, according to her receipt, she checked out at 1612 hours. OSBORNE walked out to Warren and then south on Warren. OSBORNE then used the sidewalk on the north side of the Lakewood Board of Education to cut through to Victoria. OSBORNE advised she generally walks with her head down and was walking that way today. Approximately half way between Warren and Victoria, she noticed someone walking towards her. She remembers the person had on white, dingy tennis shoes and dark blue or black sweat pants.

As the person approached her, the suspect bumped into her left side and said, "Excuse me". The suspect had a raspy voice, like he may have been a smoker. The suspect then said, "I have a gun, give me your money". The suspect had his right hand in his pocket like he had a gun.

OSBORNE reached into her left pants pocket, with her left hand, and pulled out three hundred dollars. She had one fifty dollar bill and she believes most of the rest were in twenties. OSBORNE handed the suspect the money and she believes he took it with his left hand. The suspect then said, "give me your rings". OSBORNE had two rings on, one on each hand. OSBORNE was struggling with getting her wedding ring off of her left hand and the suspect said, "Dont look up and walk". OSBORNE kept her head down and walked toward Victoria. She then went to her home. OSBORNE then called her husband, who works at Joe's Deli on Hilliard in Rocky River. Her husband drove home and then she called police. OSBORNE advised that police arrived at her home approximately 45 minutes after the incident.

OSBORNE did not look up as she walked away and was not able to provide any other description of the suspect. OSBORNE advised she was carrying that much cash on her to purchase a birthday and anniversary present for her husband. OSBORNE had the money on her from an earlier withdrawal and did not get the money from an ATM today in the area. OSBORNE provided a written statement and advised she desires prosecution.

Officers checked the area with negative results.

OSBORNE was transported back to the scene by this officer and she was able to point out where on the side walk the incident occurred. She was on the sidewalk closer to Warren when the suspect approached her. OSBORNE does not think she would be able to identify the male if she saw him again. OSBORNE was still very upset over the incident and advised she would call if she was able to

remember any other details of the suspect.

There is a security camera on the north west corner of the Lakewood Department of Education building. John Crane was contacted and he advised he would review the tape for any possible suspects. The camera, however, is focused on the back of Marc's Plaza at this time in order to catch whomever has been spray painting the building. Crane advised he would call if he located anything of evidentiary value.

Note that the time on the receipt from Pet's Mart Plus was 1612 hours and we received her call at 1622 hours. This ten minute time frame does not coincide with OSBORNE's story that she walked home, called her husband in Rocky River to come home, waited for him to get home, and then called police. I contacted management at Pet's Supply Plus and they advised that the times listed on their registers were correct or off by only a couple minutes.
