Topic Original Report

- M.O. 1 - By running from officers in an attempt to avoid being identified by officers.
- M.O. 2 - By being the Norfolk and Southern railroad tracks without permission to do so.
- M.O. 3 - By being 17 years of age and on city property between the hours of 1100 pm and 600 am in violation of curfew.
- M.O. 4 - By being the mother of a 17 year old and permitting him to be on city property in violation of curfew.

On 4-29-08, at approximately 0315 hrs, I was on routine patrol N/B on Cove near the railroad tracks. C.O. Bunner was also on patrol with me at that time. As we crossed the railroad tracks on Cove, we observed a male in a black hooded sweatshirt and blue jeans walking E/B on the tracks, which are the property of Norfolk and Southern. When the male observed us stop at the tracks, he ran E/B from the tracks and then S/B onto Beach Ave.

At that time, C.O. Bunner and I drove to Beach and the tracks to attempt to locate the male. We checked the area for the male for several minutes, but originally were unable to locate him. As we drove S/B on Beach, we again stopped at the tracks to check for the male. I turned on my patrol vehicle's spotlight and shined it E/B down the tracks. As the light was pointed at the back of a garage located the next block east, two males were observed lying on the ground behind the garage. The garage was located just north of the railroad tracks on the west side of Fry Ave. Both males were wearing black hooded sweatshirts and blue jeans. When the light hit them, they both ran from behind the garage. They ran S/B across the railroad tracks onto Fry Ave.

I advised other officers that the two males ran from the area and provided them with the description. Officers began checking the area at the time for the males. Again, after checking the area for several minutes, the males were unable to be located and officers discontinued searching at that time.

A short time later, however, C.O. Bunner and I were S/B on Hird near South Lane. At that point, we observed a male matching the description of the male we originally saw walking on the railroad tracks, now walking W/B on South Lane. We turned on South Lane and attempted to catch up to the male. As we continued W/B on South Lane, we observed the male walking S/B from South Lane through the Drug Mart parking lot. He was heading toward Detroit. When he noticed us again, he began running S/B through the parking lot, across Detroit and continued S/B on Newman.

C.O. Bunner and I began chasing the male and as other officers arrived to assist the male, identified as ARJ/ , was taken into custody in front of 1446 Newman. Upon speaking with , he stated that he was walking on the tracks to get home from a friends house. He also stated that he ran from officers because he had just gotten off of probation and did not want to be caught out after curfew. At that time, he was placed under arrest for Obstructing official business, Criminal Trespass, and Curfew. He was handcuffed and secured in the back of 203. Inv. Pickens then transported POSANTE to LPD.

was eventually released to his mother ARA/ ROSEMARY MCCLURE at LPD. According to MCCLURE, she had no idea where had been and stated that because he was expelled from school he just runs the street at night. At that time, she was issued citation #M40412 for Permitting Curfew.
