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Topic Original Report

MO- By stabbing her live in boyfriend in the chest with a kitchen knife.

On 5/1/08, at 2331 hours, officers were dispatched to 1277 Cove #203 for a report of a man who had been stabbed in the face by his girlfriend, ARA/VERNITA WIGGINS.. Upon arrival VIC/RONNIE WASHINGTON and OIV/FREDDIE WARREN met us at the door. WASHINGTON had a puncture wound to his upper left chest. There was blood freely flowing from the wound. WASHINGTON stated his girlfriend, who lives with him, was arguing with him. WASHINGTON stated he pushed her and she came at him with the knife, stabbing him once in the chest. WASHINGTON stated she then took her friend, OIV/PHYLLIS GREATHOUSE, and went to the store to get cigarettes. WASHINGTON showed me the black handled 6 inch, filet style, kitchen knife that was in the sink and stated that was the knife WIGGINS used. The knife had been recently washed and did not have any blood on it. I took custody of the knife and later tagged it as evidence and secured it in locker number 16.

SQUAD 1 arrived on scene and immediately transported WASHINGTON to the hospital. WARREN stayed on scene with WASHINGTON's permission. WARREN stated that he and WASHINGTON were hanging out and going to sign a lease for WARREN's father. WASHINGTON said that he and WARREN were gone a long time and when they got back to WASHINGTON's house, WIGGINS and GREATHOUSE were irate and began to argue with them for being late. WARREN said that WIGGINS began to yell at WASHINGTON for smoking crack all day and selling her things to get money for crack. WARREN said that he went outside to the car to get a flashlight and when he came up, WASHINGTON told him that WIGGINS stabbed him. WARREN also said that his girlfriend GREATHOUSE also saw the incident. WARREN stated that WIGGINS and GREATHOUSE left soon after to go to the store.

After speaking to WARREN I responded to the emergency room. Dr. Hastings was treating WASHINGTON when I arrived. Inv. Register took photographs of WASHINGTON's injuries. Ptl. Brown took a written statement from WASHINGTON. WASHINGTON stated he was not sure if he desired prosecution and would not decide until he saw the extent of his injuries. WASHINGTON did not desire a protection order. WASHINGTON was later admitted to Lakewood Hospital for observation.

At 0021 hours, WARREN called from the apartment and said that WIGGINS returned home. Ptl. Brown, Ptl. Gampfer and Inv. Deucher arrived and placed WIGGINS into custody. Ptl. Gampfer transported WIGGINS back to LPD where I booked her into jail with Disp. Malloy a Ptl. D. McCarthy. WIGGINS was Mirandized and stated she understood her rights. WIGGINS told me that WASHINGTON came home and became abusive with her. WIGGINS said that WASHINGTON pushed her and then came at her. WIGGINS said she was cooking dinner and was cutting food. WIGGINS stated that she fell when WASHINGTON pushed her, and hit her head on the counter. WIGGINS stated when she got up she raised the knife to keep WASHIGNTON off of her. WIGGINS did not have any injuries from the fall. WIGGINS said that WASHINGTON charged her and impaled his own chest on the knife. WIGGINS stated the argument started over WASHINGTON smoking crack, taking her car, and selling her belongings for crack money.
