Topic Original Report

MO: By striking victim, a family member, about the arms, pulling her up from wheelchair and struggling with her

On 5-2-08 at 1734Hrs. I was sent code three with other officers to 12222 Madison Ave., the Charter One Bank parking lot, on the report of someone assaulting a female in a wheelchair and attempting to take her purse.

On arrival PO Rebraca and I found a female in a motorized wheelchair and another female yelling at each other in the parking lot. I spoke with a female identified as VIC/ROMAIN DEEVERS while Rebraca spoke with the other female, identified as her daughter, ARA/CARESSA DEEVERS.

CARESSA was very upset, yelling and crying. She would not calm down to give Rebraca an account of what had happened.

I spoke with ROMAIN who was crying also and relayed the following to me. She had responded to this location to confront her daughter about using the family car against her permission. CARESSA does not have a license and ROMAIN went to stop her from using the car. Upon confronting her, an argument ensued and ROMAIN advised that she was calling our department to respond. CARESSA became very angry, grabbed ROMAIN's cell phone and refused to return it. CARESSA then became even more angry and began assaulting ROMAIN, by struggling for her purse, causing her to be lifted from the wheelchair. She also struck ROMAIN about the arms several times. She advised that her arms and left shoulder were sore. She also pointed out a small bruise on her right forearm which was starting to form.

I then handcuffed CARESSA and advised her that she was under arrest for domestic violence.

I then placed CARESSA into the back of Rebraca's car. He then transported her to LPD. There he booked her along with assistance from CO D. MCCARTHY and Dispatcher Sykora.

While on scene we were unable to locate any witnesses to the incident.

I then spoke in length with ROMAIN who gave a written statement to the following. Earlier today at home she overheard CARESSA on the phone talking to someone about going to Columbus for the night. ROMAIN took a nap shortly after this and awoke to hear CARESSA saying goodbye. A while later ROMAIN received a phone call from a family friend. He advised ROMAIN that CARESSA was at his apartment, in the area of Ridgewood and Madison. She then suspected that CARESSA may have used the car even after being advised not to do so since she has no license. ROMAIN went outside of her building to find that the car was gone. She then went from home to the area of Ridgewood and Madison on her motorized wheelchair. On arrival she checked the area to find the car parked in the bank parking lot at 12222 Madison. ROMAIN waited for her daughter to come out to the car. When she did, ROMAIN pulled her wheelchair behind it and refused to move. She told her daughter that she did not have a license and knew that she was not to driver the car at all. CARESSA became angry and told her to move. A heated argument started and ROMAIN stated that she was going to call the police. CARESSA then grabbed the cell phone from her mother's hand and refused to give it back. CARESSA became increasingly angry and went after ROMAIN in a threatening manner. ROMAIN tried to push
