Topic Original Report

CAPT. SABALA, Sir:

On 05-05-2008, upon reporting for duty I was advised of a robbery that occurred at Chesterland and Madison at approximately 0500 hrs. The victim, McDERMOTT, had called from his cell phone and was already on his way to work and not available to make a report. Attempts to contact McDERMOTT to complete this report were made, and he contacted this officer by phone on 05-08-2008. McDERMOTT advised that he works during the day starting between 0500 and 0900 hrs., and is at various locations at work usually until 2100 hrs. It was determined that I would take the information for this report over the phone.

McDERMOTT advised that he left his house at about 0500hrs., and walked to the bus stop on the south side of Madison at Chesterland. He stated that this took maybe a few minutes. He stated that he was waiting for the bus which arrives at 0510. He advised that he was alone at the bus stop for a few minutes, when the two listed suspects came from, "around the corner." That being N/B on Chesterland at Madison. McDERMOTT estimated that the suspects appeared at 0505hrs. McDERMOTT explained that suspect #1 was a Hispanic male, 5-06- to 5-08 in height, with a slender build. He stated that this suspect removed a small gold/silver colored handgun from what he thought was the right side of a gray hoodie. This male held the gun sideways with his right hand, "gangster style" and pulled back the slide on the top of the gun with his left hand. This male then pointed the gun in McDERMOTT's face, stating, "I'll kill you motherfucker. Don't move." At this point suspect #2 reached into McDERMOTT's left rear pocket and removed his wallet. McDERMOTT stated that he did not see this suspect very well, as this male was behind him. McDERMOTT stated that this male's description was based on his peripheral vision. No other pockets were grabbed or gone through by the suspects, and as soon as the wallet was removed, the suspects told McDERMOTT to walk away and not turn around. McDERMOTT advised that he turned and walked W/B on Madison towards the next bus stop. He stated that he did not turn around and did not see where the suspects went.

McDERMOTT stated that his wallet contained no money, just credit cards and identification. He stated that he had his cell phone and bus fare in other pockets of his pants, but no attempts were made by the suspects to take those items. McDERMOTT advised that he cancelled his credit cards as soon as he got to work. He stated that he did not know if attempts were made to use the cards.

In reviewing this report with other recent robberies, specifically reports 08-003317/ 08-003807/ and 08-003808, there are similarities in suspect descriptions. All these reports have two suspects, one with a semi-auto handgun, with one being white, the other being black or Hispanic.

Follow up to continue.
