Topic Original Report

M.O. 1: By breaking a rear door window to gain entry into victim's house, and removing victim's property from house without victim's permission.

M.O. 2: By writing threatening messages on victim's window while being under investigation for allegedly raping victim in a separate incident in Cleveland.

Sgt. Eschweiler, Sir:

On 05/10/2008, at 2129 hours, Inv. Mladek and I were dispatched to 1314 Hall Ave. on the report of a burglary. On arrival, we met VIC/ advised that she left the house at approximately 1530 hours. advised that the front door and two different back doors were locked when she left. further advised, however, that her son, OIV/ , who was home when she left, left the house at approximately 1730 hours on his way to work. stated that normally locks the doors, does not specifically know if he locked the doors this particular instance.

When returned, at approximately 2120 hours on 05/10/2008, and entered through the front door, observed that numerous DVD movies, normally stored in a small bookcase in the front living room, were strewn about the front living room. also noticed that a glass dinner table was smashed, and that two full black garbage bags were in the kitchen, near the back door in the kitchen. then observed that the window on the second back door was smashed, with glass shards inside the house. then called LPD.

advised that the front door was locked when she returned to the house. We observed that the rear door in the kitchen, near the two garbage bags, as well as the rear door with the broken window, were unlocked. No pry marks were observed on any of the doors, and no items, which were likely to have been used to break the window, were identified or located.

advised that a Nintendo Wii video game system, an X-Box video game system, and a computer tower and flat screen monitor were missing from the living room. Approximately 50-60 DVD movies were strewn about on the living room floor. The glass table was completely smashed.

In the kitchen, we observed two black garbage bags. Inside the bags were another approximately 100 DVD movies and a combination printer/fax machine. advised that the printer/fax machine came from the living room. Beside the bags were a PlayStation 2 video game system and a DVD player. advised that the PlayStation 2 and DVD player came from upstairs bedroom. Also beside the bags was jewelry box and assorted pieces of jewelry. stated that the jewelry box came from her upstairs bedroom, and that no jewelry appeared to be missing.

then showed us a mirror on the wall in the upstairs hallway. The mirror was marked in a green marker, with the words "Pay Back Bitch".

The covers and mattress to bed in her upstairs bedroom appeared to have been tossed around. Additionally, all the drawers to dresser drawer were open and lying on the floor. Two boxes that were stored in the closet were opened and laying on the floor in the middle of the room.

advised that nothing appeared to be missing from the drawers or the boxes, though the contents were jumbled or strewn about the floor.

In addition to the PlayStation 2 and DVD player, a flat-screen television, which had been mounted on the wall, was missing from bedroom. stated that the only item missing from the third upstairs bedroom, used by , was a laptop computer.

We then walked down to the basement. stated that a television was missing from atop a television stand in the basement. advised that nothing else in the basement appeared to be missing or to have been disturbed.

advised that she believes SUS/JEREMY A. QUINONES is responsible.

, who moved into the house on March 28, 2008, does not know how QUINONES may have found where she lives. indicated, however, that she and QUINONES have a number of mutual friends, some of whom may have provided QUINONES with her address. has not received telephone calls or other messages, threatening or otherwise, from QUINONES.

did not have a telephone number for QUINONES, nor did she have a cell phone number for . We thus were unable to speak with , who was at work. We spoke with neighbors at 1306, 1307 and 1310 Hall Ave., though nobody at those addresses saw or heard anything. Nobody answered the door at 1311 Hall Ave.

Inv. Mladek processed the scene for evidentiary purposes.

QUINONES has a CCH, with FBI number [REDACTED], and BCI number [REDACTED]. The CCH shows that QUINONES was arrested on March 7, 2008. Dispatched contacted Cuyahoga County, which advised that QUINONES was released from their facility on March 11, 2008.

desires prosecution in the matter, and was advised regarding solvability.
