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Topic Original Report

MO - By tilting in the victim's front window to gain entry in the house and then assaulting her immediately once inside causing physical harm.

On 5-13-08, at 2312 hrs., a male, later identified as (ARA) EDWARD L JONES, called 911 from 2126 Quail St. requesting the police. JONES stated there was "a mother on Quail who was on crack." JONES denied calling from 2126 Quail when asked by dispatch. JONES hung up the phone before giving dispatch his name. Dispatch advised they heard some commotion in the background before JONES hung up the phone.

I responded to the scene with P.O. RUSNAK. While en route, a female called from 2123 Quail Avenue. She stated the neighbor, from across the street, were fighting and that one of them was on her front porch.

Moments later, (VIC) PAMELA OUTLAW called 911 from 2126 Quail stating that JONES came into her house through a window and attacked her. She stated that JONES left on a bicycle toward Magee St. The area was checked for JONES with negative results. I responded to 2126 Quail and spoke with OUTLAW who advised the following: It should be noted that JONES is an ex-boyfriend of OUTLAW's and they broke up in December of 2007. Also, in the CAD premise file for LPD (03312008), OUTLAW has requested that if JONES is found on her property on Quail, he is to be arrested for Criminal Trespass. They do not live together.

OUTLAW stated she was at her house with her son, (OIV) . . . OUTLAW received a call from JONES on her cell phone around 2302 Hrs. JONES told her he was in trouble and needed some money. OUTLAW told JONES she did not have any money. OUTLAW told him not to come over to the house.

A short time later, OUTLAW was in her kitchen when she heard a noise coming from the front of her house. She went to the front living room window and pulled up the shade. When she did, JONES tilted the window inward and started to crawl through.

The window JONES came through tilts in for easy cleaning. This is what JONES did to get inside without breaking the glass. WHe climbing through, JONES knocked some picture frames off a table that were directly underneath.

Once inside, he started to grab at OUTLAW and a struggle ensued. JONES grabbed OUTLAW's shirt and was pulling at it stretching it out.

OUTLAW got away from JONES and ran upstairs to get the telephone to call police. JONES followed her into her bedroom. As OUTLAW was reaching across her bed for the phone, JONES hit her in the mouth. JONES got on top of OUTLAW and put his hands around her neck. OUTLAW stated that JONES told her he was going to kill her and that he didn't need her.

OUTLAW stated she did not fight back and JONES eventually started calming down deciding to let her go. She stated he was still yelling at her, but was not assaulting her anymore. JONES went into the bathroom. When OUTLAW heard the water running, she ran from the bedroom and went back

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downstairs to get out of the house.

JONES followed her again and soon caught her right before she got out of the front door. She managed to get out of the house and ran across the street to 2123 Quail. JONES followed her across the street and grabbed her by the hair. JONES told OUTLAW to "get your ass back across the street."

At this time, OUTLAW noticed (WIT) GUADALUPE SEDLATSCHKEK walking down the street. OUTLAW yelled to SEDLATSCHKEK to check on her son. SEDLATSCHKEK started to walk towards OUTLAW's house.

JONES let OUTLAW go and he ran back into her house. JONES then called 911 from OUTLAW's home phone. After speaking with dispatch, JONES hung up the phone and left the scene on his bicycle.

OUTLAW called police moments later. OUTLAW provide me with a written statement of what happened. OUTLAW stated that _____ was sleeping in his bedroom and did not witness the assault.

In assessing OUTLAW's injuries, she had some cuts on the inside of her mouth that were bleeding. Her clothing was stretched out and she had some hair falling off of her head. OUTLAW had a small cut on the left side of her neck that was bleeding. OUTLAW did not wish any medical attention.

INV. FIORITTO responded to the scene and took photographs of the scene and of OUTLAW's injuries. Nothing of evidentiary value was located at the scene.

I spoke with SEDLATSCHKEK. She stated that she was walking down Quail when she heard some commotion coming from inside 2126 Quail. She does not know OUTLAW. SEDLATSCHKEK stated that she saw OUTLAW run outside the front door and saw a male chasing her.

SEDLATSCHKEK stated that OUTLAW asked her to check on her son. She stated she started to walk towards her house, but stopped when the male ran back inside the house.

OUTLAW stated that JONES lives at 11821 Detroit Ave #11. This information was given out to P.O. RUSNAK and P.O. ORTIZ. They responded to that location and JONES answered the door. JONES was placed under arrest for Aggravated Burglary.

P.O. RUSNAK transported JONES to L.P.D. JONES was booked in by P.O. RUSNAK and P.O. PERHACS for that same charge.

SGT. L. WILKINS made a compact disc with a recording of all of the 911 calls made to police. This disc was tagged as evidence and placed into locker #17 in the LPD property room.

I contacted Children Who Witness Violence and spoke with Maralyn McQUEEN. She was made aware of the situation.

JONES has a CCH with a FBI # _____ and a BCI # _____ with prior for Felonious Assault, Child Endangering and Drugs (F).

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
