Topic Original Report

M.O.: By forcing open locked rear door to victim's house to gain entry, without victim's consent.

Sgt. Eschweiler, Sir:

On 05/15/2008, at 0028 hours, Inv. Deucher and I were dispatched to 1348 Thoreau Rd. on the report of a break-in. On arrival, I met VIC/FAKHRI I. DAIFALLAH, who lives at the house. DAIFALLAH advised that he left the house at approximately 2200 hours on 05/14/2008 to go shopping. When he left, DAIFALLAH locked the front door, and the handle lock to the rear door. DAIFALLAH did not lock the dead bolt on the rear door.

DAIFALLAH returned to the house at approximately 0020 hours, on 05/15/2008. DAIFALLAH pulled into the driveway, and walked around to the rear door. As he approached the rear door, DAIFALLAH noticed that, while the screen door was closed, the main rear door was open approximately two inches. DAIFALLAH pushed the door open with his foot, saw that nobody was inside the main level, and called LPD.

I observed pry marks on the door frame, where paint appeared to have been scraped off. There also was an approximately one inch indentation under the handle on the door itself. We searched the house, the back yard, and neighboring yards, but did not find anybody. DAIFALLAH stated that the pry marks and the indentation were not there when he left. DAIFALLAH walked through the house, and advised that nothing appeared to have been taken or disturbed.

It should be noted, however, that we found a mallet-type hammer lying the grass in the back yard, with a broken handle. DAIFALLAH advised that the hammer was not his, and that he had never seen it before. Additionally, a section of the wooden fence behind the garage was pulled down, leaning against the rear wall of the garage. DAIFALLAH advised that this damage was not there the last time he was behind the garage, sometime in the afternoon of 05/13/2008.

I spoke with a neighbor at 1346 Thoreau Rd., who did not see or hear anything. I knocked on the door at 1350 Thoreau Rd. and 1352 Thoreau Rd., but nobody answered.

Inv. Deucher processed the scene for evidentiary purposes. Inv. Deucher tagged the hammer as evidence and secured it in the property room.

DAIFALLAH has no suspects in this matter, but desires prosecution in the event one is identified. DAIFALLAH was advised regarding solvability.
