Topic Original Report

M.O.: By breaking a basement window, entering the listed residence, and taking the listed items without the owner's consent

SGT Spaetzel, Sir;

Detailed to 1430 Gridley on 5/19/2008 at 1617hrs on the report of a burglary. INV WALLING had already been detailed and was processing the scene upon my arrival. INV WALLING advised that the homeowner and her 16-year-old son were home upon his arrival.

The homeowner, VIC/SONJA JONES, advised that her son called her at work at approximately 1545hrs and told her that the house had been broken into. JONES responded immediately to the house and notified LPD upon her arrival. JONES stated that her and her son, VIC/ , left the house on the morning of this report at approximately 0730hrs. JONES went to work and COFIELD went to school.

arrived home from school at approximately 1530hrs to find the front door to the residence wide open. A security system had been installed over the previous weekend and was giving off an audible alarm. Unfortunately, the alarm monitoring service has not yet been activated. entered through the front door and noticed that a television that had been in his bedroom in the basement was near the front door on the couch. went into his basement bedroom and noticed that his listed XBOX 360 video game system, video games (Grand Theft Auto 4, Rainbow 6 Las Vegas 2, Call of Duty 4), and movie (Cloverfield) were missing. also saw that the listed pane of glass had been removed from a basement window near his bedroom. did not notice any other items of his missing.

JONES arrived home and checked her upstairs bedroom for missing items. JONES found a money box opened and empty laying on her bed. JONES keeps the box on a top shelf in the SW closet of her upstairs bedroom. JONES advised that she had recently put \$100.00 of assorted coin currency and \$40.00-\$50.00 of \$1.00 bills into the box. JONES did not find any other items missing from her room or the rest of the house. JONES advised that serial numbers for the listed items were unavailable at the time of this report. JONES will attempt to locate the serial numbers and forward them to LPD if she is successful.

It should be noted that other items of value were located throughout the house and were undisturbed, including: a large LCD TV, dvd player, dvd movies, and stereo equipment. Also, JONES advised that there have been two other break-ins at her residence currently being investigated by the LPD Detective Bureau. JONES will prosecute if an arrest is made.

INV WALLING took photos and processed the scene for latents, shoe prints, and blood evidence.

Prior to clearing the scene, I canvassed the neighborhood with the following results: LARRY SEIDEL was working in his yard between 0830hrs-1630hrs at 1436 and did not notice anyone coming or going from the house. JIM NAGY at 1435 did not notice anything suspicious. JENNIFER CAULKER at 1431 reported that an unknown red two door vehicle with an adult and three children inside was in the area at
