Topic Original Report

MO/ By shattering a glass door to gain entry to a business and taking property of value without permission.

On 5-24-08, at 0037 hours, units were detailed to Madison Food Center, at 12503, on an alarm. COM/PUSATERI called dispatch. He reported that it looked like two males broke into the store. They were last seen headed SB on Quail.

PO GAMPFER responded to the area. She had two males run WB from her from Dowd. Units responded to the area. The area was checked with negative results.

The back door of Madison Food Center was found shattered. There was nothing to indicate how it was shattered. The business was checked and a pack of Newport cigarettes was found out of place. The pack was lying in the hallway leading in/out of the back door.

VIC/PATEL, the owner of Madison Food Center, responded to the scene. He played the store video for us. The video showed a BM, in a red hooded sweatshirt, and a WM in a black hooded sweatshirt with white or silver lettering on the back. The two enter the store through the back door area. They both appeared to have a white mask covering their face. The males got low to the ground and crawled back towards the office area. The male in the dark sweatshirt ran to the back and disappeared from the camera view. The male in the red hooded sweatshirt took money from an open cash register. He tried unsuccessfully to open a second cash register. He threw the money into a black bag. He took some cigars and cigarettes and threw them into the bag.

The male with the black sweater came back into view of the camera. He had several cartons of cigarettes under his arm. He also had a black bag with him. The males grabbed some lottery tickets and left. They dropped items along the way and had to come back for them.

A red hooded sweatshirt, and a white t-shirt were found in the driveway of 2020 Halstead. The t-shirt had some dried fluid on it. The hooded sweatshirt had an empty pack of Basic cigarettes in the pocket. INV Register collected these items. He tagged them and secured them in the property room and marked the clothing as biohazard. He also checked the cigarette pack for fingerprints with negative results.

PO Molnar was called to Madison Food Center to view the tapes. He identified one of the males as SUS/SEIDOWSKI. He later advised the other male was SUS/JOHNSON.

PO GAMPFER checked the area where the suspects first ran from her. She located two black bags in SE corner of 2039 Dowd. A black hooded sweatshirt with light colored images was found covering one of the bags. One bag had cash, lottery tickets, cigarettes and cigars in it. This bag was hanging on the fence. 5 cartons of cigarettes were on the ground below the bag. The bag covered by the sweatshirt contained misc bottles of alcoholic beverages. These items were photographed and collected by INV DEUCHER.

INV DEUCHER brought the items back to Madison Food Center. PATEL stated the alcoholic beverages came from his store. I tagged the cigarettes, the cigars, the alcoholic beverages, the lottery

tickets and the cash as evidence. They were released to PATEL at his store. PATEL believed \$20.00 cash was unaccounted for. He believed we recovered everything else that was taken from his store.

PATEL stated he desired prosecution. He made copies of the store video. We attempted to play the CD's he made at the station. We could not get the CD's to play. The CD's were tagged as evidence and secured in locker 11, in the property room.
