Topic Original Report

MO: By entering house via an unlocked front door of the home and taking the listed X-Box and the two listed games from the top of entertainment center without the owner's permission.

On 6-5-08, at 0944Hrs. I was detailed to 2150 Dowd Ave., the front apartment, on the report of a X-Box game system and games being taken from the home.

On arrival, I spoke with VIC/DANIEL COMER who relayed the following. Yesterday his cousin, SUS/L.C. HAMPTON, had stopped by for a couple of hours, for the first time, and played the listed game system with him. He had left and several hours later, COMER went to bed around 0200Hrs. COMER woke up, around 0930Hrs., to find HAMPTON standing over him. COMER asked what he was doing there. HAMPTON explained that he had a court case at Lakewood Court today. HAMPTON mistakenly thought his case was scheduled at 0930Hrs. and was informed that it was later in the day. Since he had time on his hands, he told COMER that he thought he would stop by and see him. COMER got out of bed and made his way to the living room with HAMPTON. He immediately noticed his game system missing along with the two games from the top of the entertainment center.

COMER immediately suspected HAMPTON of taking the items since he had a history of such behavior. COMER questioned him about this but HAMPTON denied having any knowledge of the theft. He also asked HAMPTON how he got into the apartment. He told COMER that the door was unlocked and that he simply walked in.

COMER thought that he had locked the door earlier in the morning but was unsure.

I checked the windows of the apartment and observed no signs of force to them or the doors.

COMER stated that his roommate, OIV/GEORGE COOK, had been sleeping last evening but had left prior to my arrival. He spoke with him to ensure that he had not moved the items.

HAMPTON was on scene on my arrival. He was calm and denied taking the items. He relayed the same version of events to me that he stated to COMER.

COMER found his cousin's visit unusual and suspicious. He feels that he had taken the items, given them to his girlfriend who has a vehicle and then returned to wake him up in an attempt to avoid suspicion. He also pointed out HAMPTON's calm attitude after being accused of a crime by his cousin. HAMPTON was on his phone much of the time. He was relaying directions, claiming that he was trying to get his girlfriend to pick him up. After making sure that I needed nothing else from him, he walked towards Madison instead of directing his ride to our location.

COMER advised that HAMPTON's girlfriend drives a silver Saturn with a broken back, side window. He had never met her and did not know her name. COMER saw the vehicle when HAMPTON drove it there yesterday.

I radioed for ET and INV. GEARY was dispatched. Prior to his arrival, I asked him to see if HAMPTON was picked up by anyone. After waiting for over twenty minutes, HAMPTON was never picked up and walked east bound.

INV. GEARY responded to the scene and checked the entertainment center. The cables had been taken by the suspect and he determined that there was nothing of value to process.

I contacted Game Stop and The Exchange in Lakewood. Managers at both locations advised that they had just opened and that nothing had been traded in yet.

I later checked and found that COOK had a warrant with our department for Contempt of Court on a marijuana charge.

HAMPTON has an extensive CCH that includes arrests/convictions for Burglary, B & E, Theft and Domestic Violence. HAMPTON's FBI # is [REDACTED] and has a BCI # of [REDACTED].

COMER provided me with a serial number from his receipt for the X-Box. There was no serial number listed for the disc drive.

Dispatch later entered the X-Box into the computer as stolen.
