Topic Original Report

MO: By entering the attached garage door through a pet swing door to enter the unlocked door to the house and take a computer and jewelry without the knowledge or consent from the owner.

Sgt. Gannon, Sir;

On 6/12/2008, at 2254 hours, I was detailed to 14000 Lake on a report of a burglary. On arrival I spoke to VIC/ NUNZIO TRAINA and he advised the following: He stated that at 1850 hours his daughter, VIC/ GABRIELLA, left the residence to go to her boyfriend's house. She was the last to leave. The family arrived home around the same time at 2245 hours. NUNZIO advised that they entered the house through the door from the garage. NUNZIO noticed that the pet door on the rear garage door had been removed. They went inside and GABRIELLA noticed that her laptop computer was missing from her bedroom. NUNZIO's wife, VIC/ CAROLINA TRAINA, went to their bedroom and noticed that the drawer to her nightstand was open and a black box that contained her son's necklaces was on her bed. The box had been in the nightstand. She noticed that 6 necklaces were missing. They did not notice anything else missing.

The following was observed: The rear gate to the wooden privacy fence was open. NUNZIO advised that it had been closed. Someone then went to the rear door to the garage. They entered the locked door through the 1 1/2 x 2 1/2 pet door. The metal swing door on the inside of the door was removed and placed to the side. After entry was gained into the garage, someone entered the house through the unlocked door from the garage. Someone went upstairs into GABRIELLA's bedroom which is in the south/west corner of the second floor. Her Gateway laptop was on her bed and is now missing. Nothing else was missing from her room. Someone then went to CAROLINA's bedroom in the south/east corner. Someone opened the nightstand drawer that was next to the bed. They removed a black box that contained necklaces and placed the box on the bed after removing 6 necklaces. CAROLINA did not know the lengths of the necklaces and advised that three were gold and three were silver. CAROLINA advised that the necklaces belonged to her son, VIC/

Nothing else was missing from the room. It appears that someone then unlocked the rear door of the garage and exited. It should be noted that the home was disheveled. NUNZIO advised that the house was unkept due to the family cleaning out the basement.

INV DEUCHER arrived on scene for processing. Latents were found and photos were taken. The TRAINA family advised that they did not have any suspects and they were advised of the solvability factors.

It should be noted that 14000 Lake is the first house east of Lakewood Park and is the corner house on Lake and Parkside. I checked at 14001 Lake to speak with the resident, but no one was home. I spoke to the resident of 1078 Parkside. He advised that he was home all night, but he did not see or hear anything.

At the station, dispatcher NICKLER entered the Gateway laptop as stolen in the computer system.
