Topic Original Report

MO: By entering the victim's apartment through unknown means, taking the listed currency from a container in the Northeast bedroom and leaving the apartment with the same without the permission of the victims.

On 6/14/2008, at approximately 1743 hours, I was detailed to 2095 Lark #1 on the report of a burglary. I arrived on scene and spoke with VIC/ LAURA MOORE and VIC/ BRIAN DISANTO. They advised me of the following.

On 6/14/2008, at approximately 1600 hours, MOORE and DISANTO left their apartment to visit a friend on Cleveland's near West side. They returned home at approximately 1645 hours. They entered the apartment building via the common South rear entrance. MOORE advised that she used her key to unlock the rear door leading to the kitchen of their apartment. She was surprised to find that the door was not locked, as DISANTO locked the door prior to leaving at 1600 hours. DISANTO and MOORE entered their apartment.

MOORE and DISANTO walked through the kitchen to the adjacent living room. DISANTO noticed that there was an unopened Bartles and James wine cooler on the living room table. He stated that the bottle was cold to the touch as if it was recently removed from the refrigerator. He also noticed that a pair of scissors were located under the table. DISANTO asked MOORE if she took the wine cooler out of the refrigerator and placed the scissors under the table prior to their leaving. MOORE denied doing this. DISANTO found this strange, however he picked up the wine cooler and returned it to the refrigerator. He also placed the scissors back in the kitchen area.

Shortly after this, MOORE walked into the Northeast bedroom to retrieve an article of clothing. She noticed that her change jar, which is normally kept in the closet of this bedroom, was sitting on a table in the Northwest corner of the room. MOORE stated that she picked up the bottle and carried it into the adjacent kitchen. MOORE then noticed that the listed \$100 bill, which was given to her three weeks prior by her parents, was missing. MOORE asked DISANTO if he removed it from the bottle. DISANTO denied this. MOORE and DISANTO found no other items disturbed in their apartment.

After finding the listed currency missing and the items moved around their apartment, MOORE and DISANTO decided to contact LPD. DISANTO advised that they asked their neighbors across the common hallway in apartment #2, SUB/ JOSHUA REVAY and SUB/ TARA REVAY, for the telephone number for the police department. JOSHUA provided DISANTO with the telephone number. DISANTO then asked JOSHUA and TARA if they saw or heard anything out of the ordinary. Both JOSHUA and TARA denied seeing or hearing anything strange. DISANTO also asked them if they had entered the apartment for any reason. Both TARA and JOSHUA denied this as well. DISANTO stated that both JOSHUA and TARA left their residence immediately after this conversation. MOORE then contacted LPD via her cell phone to report this incident.

Inv. Moher responded to the scene for processing. DISANTO and MOORE advised Inv. Moher and I that they thought the neighbors in the apartment behind them, #2, may have some involvement in this matter. They stated that they had a casual relationship with their neighbors. They stated that JOSHUA and MOORE were at their residence last night, 6/13/2008, for drinks. MOORE went on to explain that the jar containing the listed currency was hidden in the closet of the Northeast bedroom. MOORE

stated that TARA and JOSHUA would have had access to this area last night. MOORE continued to explain that TARA and JOSHUA are the only other residents at the apartment building. There are no other people who have access to the apartment.

MOORE also provided that TARA and JOSHUA have made comments regarding the ease of breaking into the apartments in the building. MOORE further stated that TARA advised her just after their initial meeting that they have had access to the various apartments in the building. MOORE stated that TARA did not elaborate on this further.

Inv. Moher was leaving the apartment through the rear entrance that connects to a common hallway to obtain additional equipment. As he opened the door, TARA was seen next to the rear door of apartment #1 as if she was attempting to eavesdrop on the conversation of DISANTO, MOORE, Inv. Moher and I. TARA appeared to be startled when the door was opened. Inv. Moher asked her what her business was at which time TARA denied being next to the door. Inv. Moher and I were permitted inside apartment #2 to speak with JOSHUA and TARA regarding this incident.

Once inside, we determined that they were experiencing financial problems. TARA admitted to being behind on the rent at their apartment for the last two months and advised that neither JOSHUA nor herself had employment at this time. They denied being in the apartment at anytime on 6/13/2008. They stated that they were home at the time in question. TARA permitted Inv. Moher to inspect the contents of her purse. The listed \$100 bill was not inside her purse. She had a total of \$55, 2-\$20, 1-\$10 and 1-\$5. TARA stated that they just went to the store and returned. TARA stated that they were moving from 2095 Lark #2 to 1508 Hopkins on 6/15/2008. When asked about the wine cooler, JOSHUA stated that his prints would be found on it as he purchased the beverages for DISANTO on 6/13/2008. JOSHUA also denied any involvement in the theft.

Inv. Moher processed the wine cooler and change container. He retrieved prints from the change container. He was unable to obtain any prints from the wine cooler bottle.

DISANTO was adamant that he locked the front and rear entrances of the apartment. He stated that he left the Northeast bedroom window unlocked. DISANTO advised that this window did not appear to be disturbed, as the blind was still drawn.

DISANTO and MOORE advised that they desire prosecution. They were advised of the solvability of this matter.

It may be noted that neither JOSHUA or TARA have a CCH.
