Topic Original Report

M/O#1: By fleeing from officers in a motor vehicle after being given both visual and audible signals to stop and by creating a risk of serious physical harm to others in doing so.

M/O#2: By being in possession of a vehicle that was reported as stolen to CPD.

M/O#3: By running from officers on foot to avoid being arrested.

Sgt. L. Wilkins,

On 06/18/08, at approximately 2334 Hrs., I was on patrol E/B on Detroit at W117th. The listed vehicle was in front of me and stopped at the red light. I saw that the validation sticker on the plate had a 06-08 expiration. I ran the plate and learned that it had expired on 06/04/08. Due to heavy traffic, I was unable to stop the vehicle until it was S/B on W117th passing Franklin. I activated my overhead lights and the driver eventually stopped near Madison.

The driver verbally identified himself as SUS/RASHEEN BROWN. BROWN stated that the vehicle belonged to his girlfriend. He said her name, but I wasn't able to understand him. I advised him that the plates were expired, and he stated that "her birthday was on the 4th." The front seat passenger was not wearing his seatbelt. He verbally identified himself as SUS/ERWIN JACKSON. BROWN did not seem nervous but JACKSON appeared to be. P.O. GREEAR arrived to assist. I asked him to watch JACKSON as I believed he may have given me false information and appeared nervous.

I returned to my vehicle and began running BROWN and JACKSON. I then observed P.O. GREEAR running back to his vehicle and saw that BROWN was driving away. BROWN accelerated rapidly and turned E/B onto Madison. P.O. GREEAR and I activated our sirens and began pursuing the vehicle. We notified dispatch of same.

BROWN continued E/B on Madison and approached 80MPH at one point. He turned S/B onto W85th and he and JACKSON bailed out in front of 2040 W85th. I was approximately 1-2 blocks behind the vehicle, and as I turned onto W85th, I saw BROWN running E/B into the backyards. I did not see where JACKSON had gone, but he was no longer in the vehicle.

It should be noted that there was minimal traffic and the road conditions presented no hazardous conditions during the pursuit. However, BROWN drove through several steady red lights, and was weaving in and out of the vehicles he was passing.

A resident informed us that both males had ran E/B through the yards. Descriptions of BROWN and JACKSON were radioed to dispatch and other officers. CPD was contacted and several of their officers started arriving in the area to assist.

P.O. GREEAR and I attempted to pursue the two on foot, but quickly lost visual contact. We returned to the area of our vehicles, and waited for assistance. In checking the vehicle that BROWN had been driving, the keys were found in the ignition. I confiscated the keys so that BROWN and JACKSON could not return to the vehicle and drive off again. It should be noted that Inv. PICKENS remained with the suspect vehicle throughout the incident. Several LPD and CPD officers, as well as

CPD'S helicopter arrived to assist. A perimeter was established and P.O. SCHAD and I began searching for BROWN and JACKSON with assistance from K9 ARCO.

After several minutes, a CPD officer advised us that an "informant" had observed two males, matching BROWN and JACKSON'S descriptions, run into the residence at 2141 W81st. CPD advised that they had no current OBT for this residence. We received no answer at the door and could not see anyone in the home. It should be noted that lights were on throughout the first floor. We continued checking the area with assistance from CPD'S helicopter but did not locate BROWN or JACKSON.

In checking the BMV photos from the information that BROWN and JACKSON had given me, I was able to positively identify both as the occupants of the vehicle. At this point, the decision was made to end the search and have our Officers return to Lakewood.

INV. PICKENS checked the vehicle. He found no contraband inside but stated that it had an odor of marijuana inside of same. The vehicle was towed to Kufner's and a DB hold was placed on it.

Dispatcher Malloy was able to make contact with the owner of the vehicle, OWN/TISHARAH THOMAS. She stated that the vehicle had been stolen from the parking lot where she lived, with the keys in it, but she had not yet reported it. She stated that she was at work, and OIV/IYANAH THOMAS had gone outside and started the vehicle. IYANAH then heard a child yelling inside the apartment, and went inside to see what was wrong. When IYANAH returned to the parking lot, the vehicle was gone.

TISHARAH stated that IYANAH believed that one of her brothers may have been "playing a prank" on her and this is why they had not contacted CPD and there appeared to be somewhat of a delay. TISHARAH denied knowing BROWN or JACKSON, and stated that, "they must have gotten my information from the registration." INV. PICKENS advised that there was no registration in the vehicle. IYANAH was advised that the vehicle was being towed to Kufner's and the keys would be in the property room at LPD.

INV. PICKENS later contacted Officer ZUBAL #2278 of CPD. He learned that TISHARAH had walked to the 6th district headquarters and reported the vehicle stolen. (SEE CPD REPORT #08-213601 FOR DETAILS)

I later tagged the keys and secured them in locker #17 of the LPD property room.

BROWN was found to have a temporary permit which was under 17 open suspensions. The most recent being an ALS/POSITIVE suspension from 05/19/07 to 08/17/07. A reinstatement fee is required.

Both BROWN and JACKSON have CCH'S.

BROWN has FBI#982538AC5 and BCI#J0155990. BROWN has an extensive Felony drug history.

JACKSON has FBI#525023JC4 and BCI#C281522. He also shows multiple Felony drug arrests.

I submitted a request form for the video/audio recording of the incident.
