Topic Original Report

MO-By entering the victim's home and taking a camera and wedding ring without permission to do so.

Detailed on 6-20-08 at about 1120 Hrs. to 1260 Bunts Rd. on the report of a possible Burglary. Ptl. Pietch, Ptl. Sidell and Inv. Kulczycki also responded to assist. On Officers arrival we spoke to VIC/MARY PLEWACKI who advised the following.

MARY stated that she had left the home around 0940 Hrs. to go to a hair styling appointment. At this time the home had both the front and rear doors secured. On her return home around 1115 Hrs., MARY stated she pulled her auto in the garage. The garage is located on the far west side of the home. Note that when MARY parks her auto in the garage, she actually pulls in faces north. MARY then entered the common hallway en route inside the home.

It should be noted that there are three doors in this hallway. The first would be the door exiting outside (facing south), the door leading to the attached garage (facing north) and the kitchen of the home (facing east). MARY intended to go through the door leading to the kitchen and found it to be slightly ajar.

Once inside, MARY found that some pocket change from a small ceramic dish had been spilled onto the kitchen floor. MARY stated that two dishes had been moved from a wooden shelf on the north side kitchen wall to the kitchen sink counter just west of there. The dishes had been rifled through but nothing obvious was observed to have been taken.

MARY then stated that she continued to the southwest corner of the kitchen where the table is. At this location MARY found her day planner had been gone through. A cabinet on a north wall adjacent to this table had also been gone through. MARY then called an unidentified family friend who watches over her cat to see if she had been in the home looking for something. When she was advised that they had not, MARY called LPD to report the matter.

In checking the home, the point of entry is likely the south side exterior door. Adjacent to this door is a key for the door MARY and her husband, VIC/RICHARD PLEWACKI, usually left on a ledge there. MARY stated they have never had a problem leaving the key there. The key would have been easily seen if the suspect(s) were tall enough to do so. MARY added that they leave the key outside for she and RICHARD often go out of town. MARY stated she and RICHARD don't want to inconvenience those friends of theirs that come over to take care of their pets while they are gone. MARY had no suspects in mind at the time of report.

In checking the home a number of drawers were found to have been gone through. This includes a chest on the west wall of the dining room. The dining room is north of the kitchen. Also targeted was a desk on the east wall of the living room and the bedrooms upstairs. The bedrooms affected were located on the southwest and southeast area of the home. Nothing from any of these rooms appeared to be missing at this time. The front door was found to be unlocked and this is likely to be the point of exit for the suspect(s).

MARY did find that the indexed wedding ring and digital camera were missing. The ring was taken from a shelf on the south side hallway in the middle of the first floor of the home just prior to walking up

the main staircase. The camera was taken from an island shelf unit in the kitchen from a ceramic dish.

MARY was able to provide the serial number for the camera and it was later entered into LEADS as stolen by Disp. Florjancic. MARY stated she was unsure if a picture exists of the missing ring but she would attempt to locate one to provide to Detectives. Inv. Kulczycki then processed the scene but later advised he found nothing of evidentiary value.

In canvassing the neighborhood, Ptl. Sidell and I spoke to OIV/PATRICIA FERAN. FERAN stated that around 1100 Hrs., the indexed suspect male came to her front door and rang the bell. FERAN stated that she does not answer the door under most circumstances. After a few moments passed, FERAN stated that the male walked around to the back door of her home. FERAN then went outside to speak to the male. At this time the male asked FERAN if she had any odd jobs, such as painting, he could do to earn some money. FERAN stated she did not and he then left the area. FERAN was unsure what direction the male left in. The time that FERAN claimed the male came by soliciting would have been within the time of attack at MARY and RICHARD's home.

FERAN was only able to describe the male as "older", roughly 55-60 years of age, with a slim figure and he was wearing a baseball hat. FERAN added that he "looked poor" had very few teeth. FERAN stated he may have had two total teeth in his mouth. None of the other homes checked had anyone home at this time. Parties Officers spoke to at 1275 Bunts and 1291 Bunts did not see anything unusual during the times the Burglary occurred.

FERAN was then given the report number for her records and advised on the matter.
