Topic Original Report

MO-By breaking both the rear storm door window and rear entry door window and enter home to commit a theft offense.

Detailed on 6-22-08 at about 1534 Hrs. on the report of a home being burglarized. Inv. Kulczycki also arrived to assist. Upon Officers arrival we spoke to COM/ROBERT PETRATOS who advised the following.

VIC/LENORE MONDAK is "like an aunt" to PETRATOS but is in fact no blood relative. PETRATOS stated that MONDAK and his parents were very close while he was growing up and he has stayed in touch with her ever since. PETRATOS stated that he has been watching over MONDAK's home and taking care of her cat since she was admitted to the hospital last week for an undisclosed illness.

PETRATOS stated that on 6-19-08 MONDAK asked if he could respond to the home and pay some credit card bills and homeowner's insurance for her since she did not know how long she would be in the hospital. PETRATOS then did so. PETRATOS stated that he was at the home around 2300 Hrs. that day and eventually left a short time later.

Since PETRATOS could not "figure out her system", he took MONDAK's credit cards, bills and checkbook with him when he left. PETRATOS stated he later paid the bills for MONDAK and only intended to keep those items as long as MONDAK was in the hospital.

PETRATOS stated that MONDAK was due to get out of the hospital later today. MONDAK called PETRATOS and asked him to pick her up. PETRATOS advised he would but wanted to go check on MONDAK's cat and home first to make sure everything was okay. PETRATOS stated that if something were to happen to MONDAK's cat she would be inconsolable.

PETRATOS arrived at MONDAK's home today around 1525 Hrs. PETRATOS stated he entered the home through the front door by use of a key. PETRATOS stated that as he walked through the home, things seemed "out of place". PETRATOS stated that a number of cabinet drawers appeared to have been gone through but he could not find anything obvious to be missing.

In checking the kitchen, PETRATOS stated he observed a large volume of glass on the floor and the door left partially open. Upon seeing this, PETRATOS called LPD for a report. PETRATOS later advised he found the cat hiding unharmed upstairs.

In checking the home the rear door was found to be the point of entry. The heavy exterior storm door had been locked and chained from the inside. The suspect(s) broke out the window to this door and unchained the door. Once this was done, the suspect(s) then broke out the plate glass window and unlatched the dead bolt. The suspect(s) then entered the home and apparently went through every drawer on the first floor. This includes a drawer on the south side of the kitchen, a cabinet on the south side of the dining room and MONDAK's chest of drawers on a north side wall in the living room.

PETRATOS stated that he would like the incident noted at this time but has no suspects in the matter. PETRATOS stated he would "break the news" to MONDAK and he was sure she would be both "paranoid and upset". PETRATOS stated he would try to learn from MONDAK what, if any,
