Topic Original Report

On 06/25/08, at 0054 hrs., officers were detailed to The Carlyle Condominiums on a report that a male was just robbed "at gunpoint" in his apartment. PTL CANTLIN was on scene immediately after the call was dispatched and advised that a dark blue vehicle just left the area. I spotted the vehicle southbound on Cove Ave., so I made an investigatory stop on Detroit Ave., with PTL FIORITTO and PTL SMYKOWSKI assisting to check the occupants. The occupants did not match the suspect described by (COM)LONNIE QUICK. After speaking with QUICK and (OIV)ERIC STAMPER, PTL CANTLIN advised that the male was recently seen walking south through the west parking lot of the property. At this time, a perimeter was established and PTL OBROCK and K9 SHEP were called to search for the suspect. PTL CANTLIN advised that QUICK's description of the suspect was a black male, early 20's, around 6'00", wearing a dark shirt with white stripes, long shorts, and a white bandana.

After PTL OBROCK and K9 SHEP arrived and began to search for the suspect with PTL CANTLIN and INV ALLEN, I responded to the front lobby of the building to speak with QUICK. QUICK stated that he arrived home and parked his vehicle in his designated parking space in the sub-basement of the parking garage. As he was getting his food out of the back seat of his car, he was approached by a black male. The male said he wanted to talk to QUICK, while having one of his hands under the front of his shirt. QUICK was unsure of which hand the male had under his shirt. The male requested that QUICK take him to his (QUICK's) apartment. They went to QUICK's apartment at which time the male demanded QUICK's money and any jewelry he had. QUICK stated that he did not have any jewelry and only had about \$15.00. QUICK gave the male the \$15.00 and the two males exited the apartment into the hallway. The black male requested a kiss from QUICK but QUICK denied. The male made a second request for a kiss, at which time QUICK gave the male a "peck" on the lips. The unknown male then ran down the hall, down the center staircase, and into the sub-basement parking area. QUICK followed the male, but when he reached the parking garage, the male was gone. When QUICK exited the north end of the parking garage, he notified STAMPER who advised QUICK to call LPD.

QUICK stated that he never saw a weapon and the male never said he had a weapon. QUICK stated he assumed the male had a gun because his hand was under his shirt. QUICK stated he does not know the male and he was not injured. However, QUICK stated that he desires prosecution for Robbery.

After obtaining a written statement by QUICK, STAMPER came into the front lobby and advised the following:

STAMPER was in the south end of the sub-basement parking garage when he saw the unknown black male exit the center staircase and run west between the parked cars. STAMPER walked between the cars from where he was, and when he looked to the north end of the garage, the black male was gone. STAMPER then saw QUICK exit the same staircase and walk north through the garage. QUICK never approached STAMPER or requested help. STAMPER proceeded through the garage, exited through the north door, and went to the north area of the property to check on a beach party that was taking place. STAMPER turned around and saw the black male walking south through the west parking lot. QUICK then exited the north end of the parking garage and advised STAMPER of what happened. The unknown male was gone, and STAMPER told QUICK to call LPD.

STAMPER was able to play the surveillance video from the south stairwell where the males went up to the apartment, as well as the video from the hall leading from the center stairwell to the sub-basement parking garage.

In the south stairwell video, QUICK is seen following the unknown male up to the second floor, where QUICK's apartment is. When I asked QUICK if the male knew where he lived, QUICK replied no. I asked QUICK if he told the male which apartment he lived in, QUICK said no. When I asked QUICK how the male knew where he was going when QUICK was following behind, QUICK stated that the male watched where he was turning, and proceeded up the stairs in front of him, but could not explain how this was possible when QUICK was three to five feet behind the male. The unknown male was not seen with a weapon in either hand.

In the second video, about ten seconds after the male is seen exiting the stairwell and running into the garage, QUICK is seen following behind. STAMPER advised that he will have the management of the building, or his supervisor, make copies of the videos and bring them to LPD as soon as possible.

When I asked QUICK why he followed the male out of his apartment once the male left, and then gave him a kiss on the lips, QUICK replied by saying that he believed the male had a weapon, and was scared. He was following the males directions in fear of his safety. QUICK did not explain why he would follow the male all the way to the parking garage if he was in fact being robbed at gun point, instead of calling 911. QUICK maintained that he did not know the male and has never seen him in the area before. After over an hour of searching for the male, the perimeter was cancelled and the search ended.

The phone call has QUICK speaking in a calm voice, giving a vague description of what had happened. A voice is heard in the background telling QUICK to advise dispatch that he was robbed at gunpoint. I called STAMPER, who advised that he was with QUICK at the time of the call and he was the one who advised QUICK to notify dispatch that it was at gunpoint, so the dispatch had enough important and detailed information to give to responding officers. A copy of QUICK's 911 call was made, tagged as evidence, and placed in locker #14 of the property room.
