Topic Original Report

On 7-18-08 the complainant, MARGARET JONES, came to the station to make another report concerning her perception of unknown parties attempting to enter her suite, steal her property, and/or do her physical harm.

JONES presented a CD-R disc which she claimed would prove that someone was trying to hurt her. She stated that the disc contained a picture that she had taken several weeks ago which shows a male in the house next to the double she resides in. JONES claims that this unknown male is pointing a gun at her.

In viewing the contents of the disc, the only thing visible was what appeared to be fuzzy lights from two windows.
