Topic Original Report

MO1: By taking a firearm from the victims vehicle without the owners permission.

MO2: By knowingly causing the victim to believe he will be caused serious physical harm by pointing a loaded firearm at the victim.

MO3: By discharging a firearm within the city limits of Lakewood.

MO4: By hindering the discovery and apprehension of a Felon.

On 07/20/08, at 0312 Hrs., officers were detailed to the area of the Mayfair Apartments due to several calls and complaints of someone discharging a firearm. On arrival, officers found the listed Chevrolet parked in the west parking lot of the Mayfair Apartments with the doors open. There were two males and one female found in the area of the Harry Buffalo. When officers approached them, one male was detained and the second male and the female began walking through the rear parking lot of Three Birds Restaurant. PTL W MCCARTHY, PTL MINTER, and I stopped the male and female. The male was identified as (OIV)MORICE WARD II, and the female was identified as (OIV)LASHAWN JOHNSON. WARD and JOHNSON stated that the male who fired the gun was last seen going south near Riverside, and identified him as a Hispanic male, white t-shirt, and blue jeans. Officers checked the area for the suspect, but was unable to locate him.

The first male detained was identified as (VIC)JEREMY JOHNSON. JEREMY stated that he picked up his wife, LASHAWN, at Bar 2, 15625 Detroit Ave., around bar closing. When he arrived, LASHAWN asked to have her friend, WARD, WARD's girlfriend (ARA)ALLYSON KIRKWOOD, and (SUS)MARCO, to an "after party" at one of the apartment buildings on Detroit Ave. JEREMY agreed, and stated that MARCO and WARD were arguing the entire way there. JEREMY did not know what they were arguing about because KIRKWOOD was giving him directions to the apartments while he was driving. When they got to the area of Detroit Ave. and Detroit Extension, JEREMY became upset at MARCO because MARCO began to make unwelcome comments to his wife LASHAWN. JEREMY and MARCO had a few unpleasant words with each other, at which time JEREMY told MARCO that he did not want any trouble and that he had his pistol in his center console.

When JEREMY stopped his truck in the west parking lot of the Mayfair Apartments, he said that MARCO, who was seated in the back seat behind the front passenger, lunged between the two front seats, opened the center console, and removed JEREMY's gun and magazine. JEREMY stated that MARCO then got out of the truck, walked behind the vehicle, and fired two rounds into the air. JEREMY then said MARCO walked to the driver side of his truck, got into a verbal dispute with LASHAWN, so she slapped him. JEREMY exited his vehicle and began to follow MARCO, who ran east on Detroit Ave. to the east parking lot of the Harry Buffalo. JEREMY, LASHAWN, and WARD followed behind.

JEREMY said that when MARCO got into the parking lot, he turned around, pointed the gun at JEREMY, then pointed the gun toward the sky and fired two more rounds. JEREMY stated that MARCO turned around and ran south on Graber Ave. After MARCO got about 4-5 houses south, he went east through the yards. This is when officers arrived. JEREMY provided a written, signed statement about the incident.

In speaking with LASHAWN, her sequence of events mirrored JEREMY's, except for how MARCO obtained the firearm. She said that MARCO and MORICE were never in an argument. She said that MARCO and JEREMY were in a disagreement over the comments MARCO was making to her, so JEREMY was standing up for his wife. LASHAWN stated that JEREMY said he had his gun, took it out of an unknown location, placed the gun on his lap, and the magazine on the center console. When MARCO exited the vehicle, he went to the driver's side and was thanking JEREMY for the ride. While shaking hands, MARCO reached into the truck and grabbed the gun and magazine. MARCO, while walking backward, said "Don't mess with me, I'm crazy", and fired three shots into the air. JEREMY exited the truck and all three went after MARCO. LASHAWN explained and demonstrated what happened to SGT GANNON and I.

WARD also had the same story, except for how the gun was obtained. He said that the argument was between MARCO and JEREMY about the comments being made about LASHAWN. When the truck was stopped, he exited the vehicle and began to say goodnight to JEREMY. WARD saw MARCO lunge into the front passenger compartment, then exit the passenger side of the truck and fire one shot into the air. WARD pulled his girlfriend, KIRKWOOD, out. KIRKWOOD ran from the area in fear for her life. WARD said that MARCO walked to JEREMY, who was still in the driver's seat, handed the gun back to JEREMY and said that he was sorry for firing the gun. According to WARD, LASHAWN approached MARCO and slapped him in the face for taking the gun. Somehow, MARCO reached back into the truck, grabbed the gun a second time, went behind the truck and fired two more rounds. JEREMY got out of the truck and followed MARCO down Detroit Ave. with himself and LASHAWN behind.

JEREMY and LASHAWN both stated that they only knew WARD and KIRKWOOD from the bar because WARD is a DJ, who goes by the stage name "Hot Sauce". Neither JEREMY nor LASHAWN have ever met MARCO prior to this night. They were only giving MARCO a ride because he was a friend of WARD's and KIRKWOOD's. WARD stated that he only knows MARCO by his first name, and that KIRKWOOD knows him better.

Officers checked the area where MARCO was last seen, but was unable to locate him or the firearm. INV REGISTER took photos of the scene and collected the spent shell casings from the parking lot of the Mayfair Apartments. INV REGISTER was unable to locate any spent casings in the parking lot of the Harry Buffalo. The three that were found were brought back to LPD, tagged as evidence, and secured in a locked locker in the property room.

PTL LEANZA made several attempts to contact KIRKWOOD at her residence and via telephone, in an attempt to get information on MARCO, but she would not cooperate. She was subsequently arrested for Obstructing Justice(F) by PTL LEANZA.


The firearm was entered stolen into LEADS by Dispatcher Kluiber on 07/20/08 at 0649 hrs.
