Topic Original Report

Sgt. Donahue sir,

On Wednesday 7/30/08 at 1115 hrs. I, along with the US Marshal's Violent Fugitive Task Force went to 16021 Madison #2, to arrest SUB/DARNELL E WALLER. WALLER was wanted out of the Cuyahoga County Sheriff's Office for agg burglary and robbery. Task Force officers learned that WALLER was staying at that address with his girlfriend.

While officers were surrounding the building and preparing to hit it, we learned that WALLER was out front of the building walking along Madison. WALLER was spotted and quickly apprehended in front of 16209 Madison by US Marshal Brian Koerbel and US Marshal Tim Hornung of the Fugitive Task Force.



WALLER was handcuffed and secured. While conducting a search incident to WALLER's arrest, US Marshal Koerbel located a handgun tucked in WALLER's front pants waistband. The listed handgun was found to be a plastic toy air soft gun which is an exact copy of a Walther P99.

WALLER did not reach for the gun while engaged with officers, and did not threaten anyone with it. He stated that he had the gun because he was robbed before.

The gun was confiscated, tagged and secured in the basement property room.

I contacted Sgt. Donahue and advised him of the arrest with the gun and asked him to check if there were any crimes committed in Lakewood with a suspect and gun which matched WALLER. Sgt. Donahue was going to check.
