Topic Original Report

M.O.: By entering victim's residence through an unlocked window, and taking X-Box and \$230 without victim's permission.

Sgt. Eschweiler, Sir:

On 08/02/2008, at 1909 hours, I was detailed to 18716 Sloane Ave. on the report of a burglary. On arrival, I met VIC/KENT S. KRIVICH, JR. KRIVICH advised that he left his residence at approximately 1600 hours, on 08/02/2008, exiting through the back door. KRIVICH stated that both the front and rear doors were locked, though the dead bolts to each were unlocked. When he returned, at approximately 1830 hours that same day, he was unable to enter the back door, as the dead bolt was secured. KRIVICH walked around to the front of the house, and noticed that the screen to the window nearest the front door was pushed in, laying against the window frame. The window was pushed open. KRIVICH advised that both were closed when he left the house earlier. KRIVICH advised the dead bolt to the back door was not locked when he left.

With no other way into the house, KRIVICH crawled through the window. He noticed that the indexed X-Box was missing from the front room of the house. KRIVICH also noticed that approximately \$230 was missing from a television stand in his bedroom. KRIVICH advised that he remembers seeing both the X-Box and the money shortly before he left the house at 1600 hours.

KRIVICH stated that he has two roommates, both of whom are out of town, and not expected back for a couple of days. KRIVICH called them, and both indicated they had not been home that day. KRIVICH did not have the serial number for the X-Box, but advised he would call if/when he locates it.

Inv. Register arrived, and processed the scene for evidentiary purposes.

KRIVICH has no suspects in this matter, but wishes prosecution in the event one is identified. KRIVICH was advised regarding solvability.

I checked with neighbors at 18712, 18714, 18718, and 18720 Sloane Ave. Nobody saw anything suspicious.
