Topic Original Report

MO-By forcing open the side door at the victim's business and leaving the area with currency.

Detailed on 8-6-08 at about 0715 hrs. to 13415 Detroit Ave. (CPY/SOCIETY DRY CLEANERS) on the report of the business broken into sometime overnight. Inv. Kulczycki also responded to assist. On arrival Officers spoke to VIC/EMMANUAL HADGIGEORGIU who advised the following.

HADGIGEORGIU stated that he arrived at SOCIETY DRY CLEANERS at about 0715 Hrs. to open up for the day. In doing so, HADGIGEORGIU stated he parked his van on the sidewalk on the west side of the building, adjacent to the side door. At this time HADGIGEORGIU found this door slightly ajar. HADGIGEORGIU then entered the business through the secured glass front (north side) door. In checking the door he found to be ajar from the inside, he noted the dead bolt securing it was partially removed and it had obviously been forced open. HADGIGEORGIU also found both cash registers at his front counter had been gone through. HADGIGEORGIU immediately called LPD to advise us of the incident.

In checking the business, the point of entry was determined to be the west side door of the building. This door had fresh tool marks, possibly from a pipe wrench, on the door handle. It was later learned that this door is only secured by a manual dead bolt inside at the top of door. This dead bolt then secures to the frame inside. No lock is in place on the door handle. Also note, the business does not have an active contract with an alarm company, although some equipment exists, and there are no security cameras running inside. The suspect(s) then pried back the door gradually, possibly with a crowbar, until the dead bolt finally gave way. Tool impressions were clearly visible in two places on the outer edge of the door frame.

The suspect(s) then entered the business and targeted both cash registers located at the front counter. The first register was located on the south side of the counter. This register was both closed and the drawer locked. However, the key for the drawer had been left in the lock. The suspect(s) then opened this drawer and removed the indexed bills from inside.

The second cash register targeted was located on the east side of the same counter. The register was also closed and the drawer locked however, it had no key left in the lock. The suspect(s) then forced open this register causing irreparable damage to the register. Tool marks were clearly visible on the edge of the drawer frame for this register. HADGIGEORGIU estimated that a total of \$100.00 was taken from both drawers during the break in. Inv. Kulczycki performed ET at the scene. See his supplement for details.

HADGIGEORGIU was advised on the report and then given the report number for his records. HADGIGEORGIU further advised that the business was open yesterday. OIV/OBRENIJA HADZIKADUNIC closed up around 1830 Hrs. on 8-5-08. HADGIGEORGIU stated that HADZIKADUNIC is a good employee and he does not suspect her as being involved. HADGIGEORGIU stated he would speak with HADZIKADUNIC about this incident later today. HADGIGEORGIU stated he doubts HADZIKADUNIC would have any suspect(s) in mind but would let LPD know if one is developed.
