Topic Original Report

MO: By forcing open bedroom window screen, enter the bedroom to remove currency and leave the area with same without the owners consent.

On 08/13/08 at 1522hrs. INV. GEARY and I were detailed to 17465 Woodford for a Burglary report. Upon arrival we spoke to VIC/ANN DOPIERALSKI who reported the following. DOPIERALSKI left for work this morning at 0430hrs., and left her bedroom window open. The screen to this bedroom window was closed. The containers on the bedroom dresser were gone through and \$200.00 was removed from a small metal lock box that she kept under the dresser. DOPIERALSKI also stated the mattress to her bed was moved off the frame. DOPIERALSKI locked her home before she left, and only leaves the bedroom window open for her two cats. The windows in the house have been upgraded to double hung vinyl clad, and not the older style windows.

This is a double home and DOPIERALSKI lives on the first floor. There is a front door and rear door to the home with no evidence of any forced entry. Each door has a dead bolt, which work properly. In checking the interior, the front door leads into a living room, which then leads into the kitchen. The rear door also leads into the kitchen. There is a bathroom next to the kitchen, and the only bedroom is next to the bathroom. The bedroom is in the Southeast corner of the home. The window that was entered is in the East wall of the bedroom. This window is next to the driveway for 17465 Woodford, and would be visible from the street. There is another window in this bedroom in the South wall, and to the rear of the house. There was no evidence of any forced entry on the East wall window. The screen to this window does not have any locking device and can easily be pushed open from either the inside, or outside of the home.

DOPIERALSKI had two containers on her dresser which were left open, but nothing was removed from either of them. The tan metal lock box that DOPIERALSKI placed under the same dresser contained her currency. The lock box was not secured even though there is a small lock on it. There is a large glass bottle filled with change in DOPIERALSKI's bedroom that was not removed. DOPIERALSKI did not report any other items missing at this time. DOPIERALSKI stated no one knew she kept her extra money in the lock box. DOPIERALSKI does not have any suspects, but she desires prosecution in this matter. DOPIERALSKI has lived in this home for the past six weeks, and does not know who the previous renters were.

Inv. GEARY processed the scene and found nothing of evidentiary value. I checked with the neighbors and OIV/MARY ZIMMERMAN reported she saw the bedroom window open about 1100hrs. this morning. ZIMMERMAN lives one East of DOPIERALSKI, and has a view of the bedroom window. The following neighbors were also checked, 17467 and 17476 Woodford did not see anything. There was no answer at 17462 and 17468 Woodford.
