Topic Original Report

M.O. By breaking out the front window of the business, by unknown means, to gain entry to the business, and taking the listed money without permission.

On 8/14/08, at approximately 0623 Hrs, officers were dispatched to Brennan's Gift Shop at 13396 Madison, for a broken window. Upon arrival, we were approached by COM/ JOSEPH A. HAMPER, who stated that he heard the window get broken. HAMPER stated that after he heard the glass break he looked outside and saw that the window had been broken, and then called Lakewood Police. HAMPER stated that he did not see the person who entered the business.

At that time we found the east most window on the south side of the building had been broken by unknown means. The bottom right corner of the window had been broken out, and there was a hole in the window large enough for a person to gain entry to the business. It appeared that the suspect had been cut while leaving through the same window, and there was a trail of blood on the sidewalk leading from the broken window. We followed the blood trail around to the back of the business and through residential yards, heading north on Lewis from the back door of the business. The blood trail was followed through the front yards of Lewis, over the sidewalks and driveways, and ended in the street in front of 1661 Lewis. The blood trail ended in the middle of the road and could not be located after that. It appears as if the suspect may have gotten into the drivers side of a vehicle parked in front of 1661 Lewis and left in an unknown direction.

While following the blood trail, however, Ptl. Harner located the listed cash drawers under bushes in front of 1669 Lewis. Both drawers still had some miscellaneous change in them. The drawers and the change were also covered in blood.

While at the scene, Inv. Fioritto was approached by WIT/ \_\_\_\_\_ stated that he saw a chubby, white male, in his twenties, with a gray shirt, and blue and white shorts, leave the business. He had no further description on the male, and did not see where he had gone after that.

The owner of the business, VIC/ DANIEL T. BRENNAN, met us at the business and let us in to check the inside of the building. Inside the business we found that the cash drawers were taken from the unsecured back office. They were unsecured, on a shelf in the office, from the night before. BRENNAN stated that it appeared that nothing else was taken at this time. According to BRENNAN, there was approximately \$200 in each drawer, which was now gone.

Inv. Fioritto and Inv. Allen, were at the scene for E.T. work. Photos were taken, and blood samples from the cash drawers and the sidewalk were taken by Inv. Fioritto. The cash drawers located in front of 1669 Lewis were taken as evidence. A large piece of the broken window with blood on it was also taken as evidence by Inv. Fioritto.

BRENNAN desires prosecution in this matter should the suspect be located.
