Topic Original Report

MO: By entering the victim's apartment by unknown means, and taking a \$175.00 in US currency from her dresser without her knowledge or consent.

Lt. Warner, Sir:

On 08/15/2008, at 1857 hours, Ptl. Leanza and I were detailed to 12323 Plover #3 on a report of a burglary. On arrival we spoke to VIC/ PENNY.FULCOMER and she advised the following: she left for work at 0815 hours and returned home at 1815 hours. She found the side common doorway unlocked. She went to the second floor to her apartment and found her door unlocked. She went to her bedroom to change her clothes. She found numerous clothing items from her dresser on the floor. At this time she thought someone may have been in her apartment. She checked the pocket of a pair of shorts that were on the floor for her rent money. She found that \$175.00 that was in the pocket was now gone. She decided to fold the clothing and put it back into the dresser. She called her landlord and advised him of the situation. He told her to call the police and make a report, that is when she called LPD.

Nothing else in the apartment was disturbed or taken. She had electronics, movies and games in plain view that were not disturbed. It should be noted that FULCOMER arrived home at 1815 hours and did not call LPD until 1857 hours. She could not give a good reason as to why she waited so long to call LPD.

Her bedroom is located in the southeast corner of the apartment. Her dresser is in the southeast corner of the bedroom. FULCOMER advised the currency was in denominations of eight twenty dollar bills, one ten dollar bill and one five dollar bill. She advised that this was half of the rent that was due at the beginning of next month. FULCOMER has no suspects and she desires prosecution. She was advised of solvability factors.

FULCOMER lives on the second floor. Apartments 2 and 4 are vacant. The male that lives on the first floor, in apartment one, was not home during the day. There were no signs of forced entry on the apartment door or the common side door. She can not recall if she locked her door this morning.

INV Register arrived on scene for processing. Nothing of value was found.
