Topic Original Report

On 8-21-08 at 0849 hours cars were detailed along with LFD Squad 2 to 1459 Winton on report from COM/JEFFREY UHL that he just found his sister, SUB/SHANNON UHL, and he believes she was deceased. Upon arrival, JEFFREY was crying hysterically and advised SHANNON was in the northwest bedroom. SHANNON was found in the northwest bedroom in a recliner. SHANNON had no vitals but was still warm to the touch. Squad 2 spoke to Dr. Nelson at Lakewood ER who pronounced the time of death as 0858 hours. On scene from Squad 2 was Flores, Cawley, and Chaky.

Also in the northwest bedroom was SHANNON'S three week old son, OIV/NICHOLAS UHL. SHANNON was sitting in the recliner facing northwest with her legs in the reclined position. SHANNON was wearing a blue t-shirt and grey sweat pants. There was a white fluid coming from SHANNON'S nose. There was no apparent signs of a struggle or foul play. The television in the room was turned off and there was a fan on in the northeast corner that was blowing toward SHANNON.

NICHOLAS was asleep in his bassinet that was against the wall in the northwest corner of the room.

Ptl. Pietch arrived on scene and advised he had taken a burglary report from this residence on 8-20-08. See original report #08-006910 for additional information on the burglary. After learning of the facts of the burglary and the totality of the circumstances today, it was determined to clear everyone out of the residence and secure the scene. Inv. Kulczycki, Sgt. Speatzel, Sgt. Ward and several detectives arrived on scene to assist. The coroners office was called at 0925 hours and advised they were responding to the scene.

Ptl. Pietch remained at the front door of the residence and kept a log of anyone who entered and exited.

The following medications were found on the nightstand next to SHANNON and the dresser against the east wall in the bedroom where she was found. Ibuprofen 600mg filled on 8-15-08 by Dr. Christian, was to be taken one every six hours, and had 21 of 30 pills left in the bottle. Alprazolam 2mg filled on 7-29-08 by Dr. Nigro, was to be taken one every eight hours as needed, and the bottle had 42 of 90 pills left. Amphetamine salts 10mg by Dr. Nigro, was to be taken one every morning, and had 13 of 30 pills in the bottle. Ciphlexin 500mg filled on 6-4-08 by Dr. Falconi, was to be taken one a day, and had 9 of 30 pills in the bottle. Diazepam 10mg filled on 6-30-08 by Dr. Nigro, was to be taken one every six hours, and had 6 of 30 pills in the bottle. Clonazep 1mg filled on 7-20-08 by Dr. Nigro, was to be taken one pill two times a day, and had zero of 60 pills in the bottle. Nystop 100,000 U/GM top powder 60mg, was to be taken three times a day. Oxycodone Ap5-325mg filled 8-7-08 by Dr. Falconi, was to be taken one to two pills four to six times a day, and had zero of 30 pills in the bottle. Clonazepam 1mg filled 8-13-08 by Dr. Nigro, was to be taken one pill two times a day, and had 41 of 60 pills in the bottle. Hydrocodone Ap 5500 filled 8-10-08 by Dr. Reedy, was to be taken one pill every six hours, and had zero of 30 pills left in the bottle. Natalcare plus filled 7-15-08 by Dr. Falconi, was to be taken one pill a day, and had 25 of 30 pills left in the bottle.

Upon speaking to JEFFREY, he advised he arrived home at 0015 hours this morning. When he arrived home, SHANNON was awake and eating a hot pocket in the kitchen. JEFFREY said that SHANNON seemed somewhat "out of it", but SHANNON just said she was tired and drowsy. JEFFREY went to bed shortly after arriving home. JEFFREY'S bedroom is located in the southeast corner of the

apartment.

Around 0300 hours this morning, JEFFREY walked to the bathroom that is just one room south of where SHANNON sleeps with the baby. JEFFREY advised SHANNON was sitting in the recliner giving a bottle of milk to NICHOLAS. He remembers the television in that room was also on at that time. JEFFREY used the restroom and then went back to bed.

At 0845 hours JEFFREY awoke and walked in to see SHANNON and NICHOLAS. JEFFREY found SHANNON who was not responsive and called police from his cell phone at 0846 hours.

JEFFREY advised the first floor front door was dead bolted last night but the first floor back door does not lock. JEFFREY also advised that the second floor front entry door was chain locked last night and the second floor rear entry door was dead bolted. There were no signs of forced entry to the residence.

The apartment was clean and appeared to have just been moved into due to the amount of boxes in the apartment. According to JEFFREY, SHANNON had moved into the apartment approximately three months ago and JEFFREY moved in at the beginning of August in order to help SHANNON with the baby.

The Coroners office arrived on scene at 1010 hours. From the Coroners office was Inv. Larry Thacker #15, Intern Kirsten Boughan, and Intern Brent Wineburg. The Coroners office did not find any signs of foul play on the body and believed SHANNON had only been deceased for a couple of hours. Rigomortous had not set in on the body. Inv. Thacker advised they would only be sealing the northwest bedroom where SHANNON was found and would let family remain in the rest of the apartment.

SHANNON'S parents, OIV/SHARON UHL and OIV/MARK UHL, arrived on scene. They advised they would take and care for NICHOLAS. NICHOLAS was given to them with all of the needed supplies from the residence.

Ady and Zents arrived in the transport ambulance from the Coroners office in unit #1002. They as well as the investigators cleared the scene at 1123 hours. Family members were allowed to enter the apartment at this time.

Sgt Ward and Det. Mclaughlin were on scene and conducted a canvas of the neighboring homes. See their supplements for additional information.

I spoke to Inv. Thacker at the Coroners office and they provided a time of death of 1140 hours. 696-kids was contacted and provided the informatin and they assigned an incident number of #486574.
