Topic Original Report

MO - By entering the victim's apartment by prying the front door and then stealing the listed DVD player, DVDs and baseball cards leaving with same.

On 8-23-08, at 2358 Hrs., (VIC) JOSEPH JANIK called the police to his apartment at 1419 Grace Ave. #1 to report a Burglary.

P.O. CANTLIN and this officer responded to the scene. I spoke with JANIK who advised that someone entered his apartment today between 1930 and 2330 Hrs.

JANIK was not sure how entry was made but he found the rear apartment door open when he came home. He stated both doors were locked when he left. The rear door was dead bolted.

In looking at the front door, I located some pry marks around the door jam. JANIK stated the marks were old, but the spring lock could be easily unlocked with a knife or flat bladed object.

It appears the suspect came in the front door due to the other entry points found intact.

JANIK advised that the DVD player was missing from a stand next to the TV in the living room. He stated 25 DVD movies were missing from a bookshelf in the dining room.

JANIK could not remember any of the movie titles that were taken. He did not know the model or serial number for the DVD player.

It appears the suspect left out the rear door as this was found open when JANIK returned home.

INV. FIORITTO responded to the scene for E.T. work but nothing of evidentiary value was found.

JANIK has no suspects. He desires prosecution. JANIK was advised of the low solvability.

On 8-25-08, at 0010 Hrs., JANIK responded to the police station with a bag of baseball cards in plastic containers. In speaking with him, he advised that he found some cards missing from the bag which he keeps in a closet in the living room.

JANIK advised that one of the cards was a "Peyton Manning" rookie card. He was going to make a list of the others and bring it back to the station if he was able.

INV. ALLEN did E.T. work on the bag and plastic containers but found nothing of value.

JANIK still had no suspects.
