Topic Original Report

Lt. SPRAGUE Sir;

Dispatched to 11719 Clifton #1 on the report of copper wire missing from the apartment. On arrival, VIC/JACKIE SKEENS advised the following:

Over the past few weeks, he has been working to remove copper wiring from various items, such as extension cords. SKEENS said that he is given these items from his employer, and he removes the copper wire so that he can sell it. SKEENS said that he had three spools of the wire sitting on a chair in his family room. He estimated that it weighed a combined 120 pounds.

SKEENS left for work this morning at 0517, and when he returned home, he immediately noticed the wire was gone. There were no signs of forced entry to the apartment. SKEENS said that his front window does not lock, and he feels the suspect(s) opened the window and reached inside to unlock the front door. It should be noted that SKEENS said the front door was ajar when he returned home, and he was positive that it was locked when he left. The door is accessible from his patio, and is clearly visible from the street.

SKEENS advised that nothing else was missing or disturbed in his apartment. He added that he thinks the resident of #3, who he knows only as "ERIC", is responsible. SKEENS said that ERIC moved in a couple weeks ago, and in that time frame, SKEENS has had money stolen from inside of his apartment twice. SKEENS did not report either incident to LPD, though he could not give a reason as to why.

SKEENS said that he went to confront ERIC before calling LPD. He claims that he knocked on the door, and heard ERIC tell an unidentified female to "tell him I'm sleeping". The female eventually opened the door, and told SKEENS that ERIC was sleeping when SKEENS asked to speak to him. SKEENS said that he told the female why he was there, and that he was going to call LPD. A short while later, SKEENS claims to have seen ERIC and the female leaving the building.

I attempted to speak with ERIC, but there was no answer at his door. Apartment #2 is currently unoccupied, and the resident of #4 said she was home all day and did not see or hear anything unusual. SKEENS desires prosecution and was advised of solvability. It should be noted that there was a large amount of stripped wire and casing sitting in a garbage bag, which would support SKEENS' claim of how he obtained the wire.

Inv. GEARY responded and found NOV.

Just prior to completing this report, SKEENS called and advised that he had located the wire. He said that the incident was a misunderstanding between him and his cousin, and that he no longer desired any type of police involvement.
