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The game system was entered into the computer by DISP. GRAHM at 1641 Hrs.

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Topic Original Report

MO: By entering the home through an unlocked front door and taking the listed items without the owners permission.

SGT. SPAETZEL, SIR:

On 090308, at 1643 Hrs. I was detailed to 2191 Clarence on the report that a party was attempting to get their property back from someone who had taken it. Upon arrival I spoke with VIC/ GINNY MASSIMIANI and OIV/ BRIAN MASSIMIANI who relayed the following.

Yesterday, on 090208, at APP. 1400 Hrs. BRIAN was at home with his step sister OIV/ C SUS/ E, and SUS/ DAVID PARADICA stopped by the house to visit with them. E used to be a foster child of the MASSIMIANI family. Sometime around 1500 Hrs. BRIAN took C over to a friends house. They all walked out to the front porch at the same time to leave the residence. BRIAN and C left north towards Detroit in a vehicle, E and DAVID left south towards Franklin on their bikes. When they left BRIAN left the front door to the home unlocked because he does not have a key to the door. BRIAN felt that once he was gone E and DAVID returned to the house and took the game system.

On 090208, when the family returned home and found the game system missing they initially accused BRIAN of taking it. He denied taking the game system and blamed E and DAVID for the theft. GINNY was going to attempt to handle this matter and give the boys a chance to return the system but no one will admit to taking it.

I went up to the porch of 2191 Clarence and spoke with E. He denied taking the system saying that everyone left the house at the same time, and that he and DAVID didn't go back to the house. He felt that BRIAN was accusing him to get the blame off himself.

I asked E 'S grandmother, OIV/ SANDRA ARTH if she would be willing to let me search E room for system. Over E objection she signed the consent to search form. PO BENO arrived at the scene and stood by with E while I searched. SANDRA led me upstairs to E room. I didn't locate the game system in the room. SANDRA also took me down to the basement advising me that this had been E room until water started leaking in. I searched the basement as well as the garage but the system was not located.

I then responded to 1446 Cohasset. I found that it was a single home on the west side of the street. The game system was taken from the second floor bedroom, S/E corner of the house. The system had been next to a TV on a TV stand against the west wall. I dusted the TV as well as the stand but didn't locate any latent prints. The family had the original box and advised me that the bar code on the side of the box was the same serial number as the game. Nothing else in the house had been taken or disturbed. It should be noted that there were other less expensive game systems and games in other bedrooms that were not taken.

On 090408, I contacted DAVID to obtain his MNI. He admitted to being at the house but denied taking the game. He too stated that everyone left the house at the same time and that he and E didn't return to the house.

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
