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Topic Original Report

M.O. - By forcing the rear door by unknown means to gain entry to the residence and taking the listed camcorder without permission.

On 9-6-08, at approximately 1930 hrs, officers were detailed to 1623 Winchester on the report of the VIC/ RENEE BATTLE's residence having been broken into. COM/ DEIDRE PEARSON, who is RENEE's roommate, contacted LPD when she returned home and noticed the rear door to the residence was damaged.

Upon arrival, we spoke with RENEE and PEARSON and learned the following: PEARSON returned home at approximately 1920 hrs and found the rear door to the residence had been forced open. Upon entering the residence, PEARSON noticed that it appeared as if someone had been in the upstairs apartment of the residence. PEARSON and RENEE own the residence which is a double. The downstairs apartment is not occupied at this time and was not entered. They live in the upstairs portion of the residence, which had been entered.

PEARSON contacted RENEE at work at that time. She advised RENEE of the situation and RENEE responded to the residence. Upon RENEE's arrival, she checked the residence for any missing items and noticed that the listed RCA camcorder was missing.

RENEE stated that the suspect(s) had entered her bedroom on the third floor of the residence and had moved several things from underneath the bed, including the black bag containing the listed camcorder. Her jewelry box in the N/E corner of the room had a drawer removed and it was placed on the dresser next to it. No jewelry was found to be missing at that time. Several other items in the bedroom had been moved, but nothing else appeared to be missing at that time.

PEARSON stated that she did not notice anything else missing from the residence either.

RENEE and PEARSON both left earlier in the morning, but stated that RENEE's daughter, OIV/ \_\_\_\_\_, was home during the day. RENEE stated that \_\_\_\_\_ was home because a technician for Cox Cable was coming to the home to set up the internet in the residence. \_\_\_\_\_ was home the entire time the technician was there. When the technician completed his work at approximately 1500 hrs, he left the residence and \_\_\_\_\_ left the residence shortly thereafter. RENEE and PEARSON do not have any suspects in the matter at this time, and they stated that the only other person in the residence during the day was the cable technician.

Inv. Fioritto arrived on scene to assist. Upon checking the rear common entrance door, it appeared as if the door was forced open by unknown means. The pressure of the door being forced open caused the door to splinter around the door latch. The latch had enough pressure on it that it was broken out of the door. After entering the rear door of the residence, the suspect(s) went upstairs to the rear door of the upstairs apartment. There was no damage done to the upstairs door. It is not clear whether the door was left unlocked or not. Inv. Fioritto took photographs of the damage and dusted for prints. A partial print was located on a silver case which had been moved from underneath RENEE's bed.

In speaking further with RENEE and PEARSON, they stated that their neighbor at 1627 Winchester had observed two males near the residence at approximately 1600 hrs. I spoke with the neighbor at

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1627 Winchester. She saw two younger, light skinned black males near the back of RENEE's and PEARSON's residence, but she did not pay any attention to them and could give no further information or description of the males.

RENEE stated that prosecution is desired in the incident and she was advised of the solvability factors.

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
