<b>N A R R A T I V E</b>  <b>1</b>	Topic	Original Report
<p>MO; By pulling a small handgun out of purse, and telling victim she should "kill" him, which makes victim fear for his safety.</p> <p>On 9-17-2008, at 1238 Hrs., I was advised to take a report at the front counter. On arrival, I spoke with VIC/RONNIE WASHINGTON, who said his ex-girlfriend, SUS/VERNITA WIGGINS came over on 9-16-08 to see him at approximately 2000 hrs. Note, WASHINGTON said WIGGINS was dropped off there.</p> <p>WASHINGTON said he and WIGGINS had resided together until about two weeks ago when she decided to move out. WASHINGTON said since then he really has not heard from her. However, WASHINGTON said WIGGINS still had a house key and property still in the apartment.</p> <p>WASHINGTON said they argued on and off during the evening over her listed auto, of which he had possession. WASHINGTON said that he had fixed WIGGINS' auto and said that she gave the auto to him. WASHINGTON showed me a handwritten paper claiming WIGGINS had basically turned the auto over to him. However, WASHINGTON never got the title and it is still in WIGGINS name. WASHINGTON said that WIGGINS wanted her auto now and demanded the keys to it from him.</p> <p>WASHINGTON said the argument got heated. He said he told WIGGINS he was not going to give her the keys. WASHINGTON said WIGGINS reached into her purse, pulled out a handgun and pointed it at him. WASHINGTON said that WIGGINS told him she "should kill" him. WASHINGTON said he calmed WIGGINS down by talking to her. WASHINGTON said this happened at approximately 2000 hrs.</p> <p>WASHINGTON said after a few minutes, WIGGINS put the handgun back into her purse. WASHINGTON said he did not see the handgun clearly and only knows it was a small caliber by the size of the muzzle. WASHINGTON said the front of the barrel was chrome and he could not describe it any further.</p> <p>WASHINGTON said he and WIGGINS talked after that and things were fine. WASHINGTON said that WIGGINS called for a cab to go back home at 2200 Hrs., but when the cab arrived she did not leave.</p> <p>WASHINGTON said he decided to give WIGGINS a ride back home around 2345 Hrs. and stopped for gas at the Marathon gas station at Lake and Detroit in Cleveland, Ohio. WASHINGTON said WIGGINS told him that she was going to get a sandwich in the store there. WASHINGTON said WIGGINS was in the store for a long time and he noticed she was talking on her cell phone.</p>

WASHINGTON said WIGGINS came back to the auto and told him they were heating up her sandwich. WASHINGTON said C.P.D. showed up, placed him in handcuffs and put him in their patrol car. WASHINGTON was advised by C.P.D. that WIGGINS called them to report an unauthorized motor vehicle report.

WASHINGTON said that WIGGINS left in the auto soon afterwards. WASHINGTON said he was yelled at by C.P.D. over this violation that WIGGINS reported. WASHINGTON said C.P.D. advised him to have no contact with WIGGINS or they would arrest him. WASHINGTON said C.P.D. then unhandcuffed him and let him walk away.

WASHINGTON said it took him awhile to walk back to Lakewood, Ohio. WASHINGTON said he saw a Lakewood police car sitting in the parking lot at 11900 Detroit (Drug Mart) and told him what happened to him. WASHINGTON said this police officer told him to walk to the front counter of the police department to make a report.

WASHINGTON said he arrived at L.P.D., he said he walked up to the front window and nobody was around. WASHINGTON said he sat down in the lobby area for awhile and nobody came out to speak with him. I asked WASHINGTON if he had rang the door bell and he said "no." WASHINGTON said he was getting tired, so he walked home.

Note, while speaking with WASHINGTON about this incident he had tears coming out of both eyes. WASHINGTON said he wants to prosecute WIGGINS for this incident.

WASHINGTON said he fears for his safety and wants a T.P.O. against WIGGINS.
