Topic Original Report

MO- By using bodily force to defeat the deadbolt lock on the victim's residence, gaining entry, removing electronics, medications, and jewelry without permission

On 09/27/2008 at 0301, I was detailed to 2125 CARABEL on the report that the resident had come home and found her house broken into. Dispatch further advised that she had not gone into the house. INV. MLADEK arrived on-scene to assist, and we cleared the house finding no suspects inside.

Entry was made via the back door. The resident, (VIC)KERCHER, said she left home at 1700hrs on 09/26/2008. She returned home at approximately 0300hrs this date and discovered her back door was damaged. LPD was then contacted.

KERCHER had her deadbolt locked on the back door when she left. The suspect apparently used bodily force to push the door inward, breaking the door frame. The back door leads into the kitchen, with the dining room North of the kitchen. Once inside the dining room, KERCHER's wallet was moved on her dining room table and gone through by the suspect. A camcorder was taken off the dining room table, and a digital camera was taken from its charger on a shelf in the Northeast corner of the dining room.

In the living room, a cloth covering a portion of a cabinet the tv was sitting on was left on the floor. It did not appear the cabinet was gone through.

The suspect then proceeded upstairs. KERCHER's overnight bag which had been on her bathroom toilet, was gone through, and its contents emptied out onto the floor. Jewelry was taken from it, as well as medications.

The suspect opened drawers in a dresser in the Northeast bedroom. Nothing was in the drawers though. In the Southwest bedroom, a picture frame box had been left on the bed. I was able to obtain a white powder latent print off the box.

Finally, KERCHER's bedroom, located in the Northwest corner of the second floor was targeted. Her bed was not made like she had left it. The suspect removed jewelry from a box on top of her dresser. Her top dresser drawer was opened and jewelry taken from it.

The side door and front door of the home were still locked when checked, so it appears the suspect left out the back door.

Photos were taken of the scene. The back door was painted wood and not conducive to processing. I was unable to locate prints on KERCHER's dresser or jewelry box or the dresser in the Northeast bedroom.

KERCHER has no suspects. Prosecution is desired. She was advised of the low solvability factor. KERCHER was given the report number and instructed to compile a list of all the jewelry taken and submit it to LPD. I did not conduct a canvass of the neighborhood due to the hour.

DISP. NICKLER entered the camcorder as a stolen article.
